

Hawthorne Fourth Grade Suggested Supply List

- 2 packages of #2 pencils (yellow, non-mechanical, **sharpened**) (Preferred Brand: Ticonderoga)
- One 1" binder - exactly 1"- no smaller or larger - no flaps or velcro
- 1 set of 5 notebook dividers with tabs for 1" binder
- 2 reams of white computer paper 8 ½" x 11"
- One 1-subject notebook with lined paper
- Two 3-subject notebooks with lined paper
- 2 red pens for correcting
- 2 blue or black pens
- 5 pocket folders with pockets on the bottom (not the sides), 1 each of green, red, yellow, purple, and blue
- 1 decorative pocket folder to be used as a homework folder
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 thin black Sharpie
- 1 package of colored markers (8 colors) (Preferred Brand: Crayola Washable)
- 1 package of 3" x 3" post-its
- 2 boxes of tissue
- 1 stylus
- 1 pair of ear buds (in a Ziploc bag labeled with child's name)
- 1 combination lock for the hall locker (Practice locking and unlocking it at home until your scholar is comfortable with it.)
- Paper towel roll
- Wireless mouse
- Set of thick whiteboard markers
- Clorox wipes

Before the first day of school visit bhusd.org. Click on "Parents" and then "Returning Students." Read the forms and then print, fill out, and send the following forms to school on the first day...

- BHUSD Emergency Card (Portal Print Out)
- Hawthorne Student Directory Form

Label the 5 binder dividers: Writing, Reading, Science, Social Studies, Math

Label the 5 folders: Reading (blue), Writing (yellow), Math (purple), Science (green), Social Studies (red)

Label the outside, upper right hand corner of the homework folder with student's name. On the inside left pocket, please label it "Complete and Return," and on the right side "Keep at home."

Students will be using hall lockers to store their backpacks. They will not be carrying home heavy books, so a non-rolling backpack is preferred. The backpack **must fit** easily inside the locker. The size of the locker is **11" wide**.

Students should enter 4th grade knowing all of their multiplication tables (0-12).

Students should be comfortable doing all writing in cursive on the first day of school.

In order to be prepared for 4th grade, students need to be reading consistently throughout the summer.
