Community

McComb School District serves the educational needs of McComb, Mississippi. Located in southwest section of the state, the district enjoys a diversified economic base. Currently, the district consists of one high school, one junior high school, one middle school and two elementary schools utilizing a preschool-Kindergarten, 1-3, 4-6, 7-8. 9-12 grade-level configuration. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 0.70% Hispanic, 87% African American, 10% white and .8% Asian.

School

Seven hundred and twelve students are in grades 9–12 grades. McComb High School is accredited by AdvancED.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a modified block schedule. Four credits per semester is the maximum course load; students take four 95-minute block classes,. Block classes are semester-long; each block class meets every day. Block scheduling was instituted in 2013.

These AP® courses are offered: Biology, Calculus AB, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, World History. AP is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in English II, Algebra II English I and Chemistry.

The Area Vocational & College Programs enables juniors and seniors to enroll in freshmen courses and earn college credits at local institutions of higher education.

Rank

The weighted GPA scale will determine Academic rank-in-class for graduating seniors. RIC will be computed on a weighted GPA basis.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

Letter grades shall be awarded the following values: A-4 points, B-3 points, C-2 points, D-1 point. (Use $\frac{1}{2}$ of the values for 1 semester courses. Use weighed values for weighted courses.

Steps to take: (1) add total points, (2), add total units, (3) divide total number of points by the number of credits, (4) carry answer two decimal places, and round off remainder to second decimal place. The non-weighted GPA is normally reported to the colleges and universities, National Clearinghouse for athletes and other institutions.
