Student Council: ASB Executive Positions: ASB Officers: President, Vice President, Secretary & Treasurer

- Applications Information Mtg: **Wed. March 8th at break and lunch**, information meetings at break in room 404
- Applications Due: **Monday March 13th**, with **mandatory meeting** at lunch in room 404- Speech due
- March 21-24- Election: Election speech on KNIT on Tues. March 21st, Elections March 22/24 in HR

ASB Commissioner Positions: Activities, Athletics, Brotherhood, Entertainment, Publicity & Link (Link is Appointed). School DJ and Mascot are interviewed by new ASB in April.

- Applications Due: **March 24th**, with **mandatory meeting** at Brk or Lunch in room 404, speeches are due too!
- Election: Election speeches on KNIT Mon./Tues. March 27 & 28, Elections are Thurs/Fri. March 30/31 in HR

Requirements to apply for all offices in Student Council:

- You must maintain a 2.5 G.P.A. or better (cumulative and in each of the 2 semesters you serve)
- You must have a 2.5 G.P.A. or better on your most recent report card to run for office
- You cannot be on Academic or Disciplinary Probation
- You must be available for all Student Council homerooms, 7:15am Wednesday work meetings, 7:45am Open Forum (first Tuesday of the month) and other meetings as they arise. All ASB officers and commissioners will attend the summer leadership camp **July 26-29th Chapman University** around a cost of \$275 per student. The spirit pack (Student Council polo & t-shirt) will be around \$50 per student that is paid in the fall.

ASB President - must be a present junior, **ASB Vice President**-must be a present junior

ASB Treasurer - must be a present junior, **ASB Secretary**-must be a present sophomore, or junior

ASB Activities Commissioner - must be a present sophomore or junior,

ASB Publicity Commissioner - must be a present sophomore, or junior

ASB Entertainment Commissioner – Must be a present sophomore or junior,

ASB Athletics Commissioner - Must be a present sophomore or junior

ASB Brotherhood Commissioner - Must be a present sophomore or junior

ASB Link Commissioner - Must be a current junior and appointed by Link Advisors (Link Application Due March 15 w/ interview on March 21 or 22 (make appt. w/ Mrs. Gunter)

Student Council Class Officer Positions for all 4 grade levels: Class President, Vice-President, 2-3 class officers.

Applications available: **Monday March 13th**, with Information meeting during break or lunch in room 404, speeches due by **April 5th** for approval (email: dgunter@sfhs.net or hand into the Activities Office to Mrs. Gunter)

Applications Due: **Tuesday March 28th**, with a **mandatory meeting at Lunch** in room 404. KNIT speeches (report at 7:30am to KNIT Studio with your own copy of speech) Monday April 10th- Juniors, April 11-Sophomores, April 12-Freshmen

Election: **April 12/13, Wednesday/Thursday** in homeroom

Requirements for Class officers are the same as ASB Officers & Commissioners, however Summer Leadership camp (July 26-29th at Chapman University) is optional but highly recommended.

Athletic Leadership Council: Athletes from each sport are nominated by their coach in the Spring to be on the ALC for the following school year. Nominees will receive an application to fill out and will be considered for membership.

LIFE Team -Campus Ministry (must be current Sophomore or Junior):

- Applications available Wednesday **March 15th**, there will be an informational meeting on during lunch in the theater.
- Applications Due: **Wednesday, March 29th**
- Interviews: March and April before, during and after school
- Announcing of LIFE team: Middle of May

Requirements to apply to all candidates for LIFE team:

- Attend LIFE Team Leadership Retreat June 6-9th, 2017
- Be current and exceed required Christian Service Hour commitment
- You must maintain a 2.5 GPA or better (cumulative, and in each of the 2 semesters you serve)
- You must have a 2.5 GPA or better on your most recent report card
- You cannot be on Academic or Disciplinary Probation
- Be actively involved in your faith tradition through your place of worship, at St. Francis, or through another ministry or organization.

Link Leader (Student Activities):

Applications available in google classroom. Must attend a mandatory information meeting to get the link on Thursday Feb. 9th or Friday Feb. 10th at break. **First or Second Year application are due Feb. 28th and supplement (video or letter) is due March 9th.** Interested students must attend one of the information meetings to get the online application & important information.

Applications due for **ASB Link Commissioner** (current Jr Link Leader. Only-see ASB Commissioner for Info): **Wed. March 15th** at a mandatory mtg. at break in 404 (sign up for Commissioner interviews: March 21/22)

1st year Link Leader online applications due in Google Classroom & class code posted announcements and will be given out on Feb.9 and 10th at break in 404: **Wednesday, March 9th, deadline** with video or new student letter. **New applicants** sign up for a Group interview: After school March 27, 2:45pm to 3:30pm, March 28th 1:45pm to 2:30pm, or Monday April 3rd 2:45pm to 3:30pm via google link sign ups once you submit your application.

Announce Link Leaders: End of April with letters in homerooms.

Requirements apply to all candidates for Link (returning and new-share mandatory dates with guardian/parents):

Attend June Development Day: Friday June 2nd, noon to 3:30pm (lunch included)

Attend Link Leader Training: Tuesday August 8th ,2017 - 8:30am to 5pm

Attend New Student Orientation: Aug.10 and 11, Thurs/Friday -7:30am to 3pm

Attend Welcome Dance, Frosh Mixer, Jan. Cheer/Link Event, etc. and daytime Leader and Link Group meetings

Club Leadership – All clubs, new and returning, need to register in the first weeks of school by a club president or representative and a teacher moderator. See Mrs. Gunter this spring if you want to start a new club in the fall.

Homeroom Representatives - Each homeroom has one representative that is elected by their respective homeroom by the end of September. There is an application process and monthly 7:45 am Wed. Open Forum meetings to attend.

NHS – Requirement of a minimum 3.6 GPA, applications are handed out to juniors & seniors in September. You cannot be on Academic or Disciplinary Probation and you must be approved by the Dean of Students. Interviews may be conducted for students if more information is needed. See handbook page 17. See Ms. Baldonado in the Counseling Office for more information.

CSF – The application is made available two weeks starting the Monday after Semester grades are posted. Application were due Feb. 3rd and again in August.
