HOMECOMING, PROM, DANCE AND SPECIAL EVENT DRESS CODE

Seton Catholic Prep wants students to make good choices, fostering respect, responsibility and integrity. These events should be fun and memorable but we also want everyone to be comfortable, safe and show Cougar pride. With modesty and safety in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be enforced:

- Dresses may not be cut below the bust line. Excessive cleavage is not allowed
- Dresses may be backless as long as it is NOT cut below the navel
- Midriffs may not be exposed. This includes both the front and sides of the dress
- Dresses must not have a slit that exceeds mid thigh (fingertip length)
- Strapless dresses are permitted
- No outfit may be skin-tight or hugging the body
- No pinning may be allowed as an alteration for a dress if without the pinning the dress does not meet dress code
- Dress/skirt length will be no shorter than 3" above the knee
- Shorts/jeans are not allowed unless it is a special or theme dance
- Shirts must be buttoned up to the second button from the collar
- Slacks should fit properly on the hip and not sag below the waistline

As you begin shopping for a dress/suit/slacks, please keep these guidelines in mind. While we will be reasonable in the interpretation of the guidelines, we want you to know that you will not be allowed to participate in Homecoming, Prom or any other dance if you are not dressed appropriately.

Important things to note:

1. Students approached us in a very respectful and responsible manner to discuss changes to dress code for school dances.
2. We expect students to revert back to "School Dress Code" when they return to school.
3. Administration reserves the right to make the final call whether dress/outfit is appropriate when student arrives at school dance.
