Known as a great historian for the community, Polly Mays served more than 20 years as chair of the Howard County Historical Commission. She spearheaded the Potton House preservation project and later supported the transfer of its control to the Heritage Museum. Mays was instrumental in commissioning and publishing a book called Howard County 1882-1982, which honored local families and detailed area history. Mays also spearheaded a project that recognized local historic sites with informational plaques for visitors and formed a walking tour of those places. Polly was one of those make-a-difference people who refused to stand on the sidelines waiting for something to happen. Polly Mays made a difference.
