INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS

(LOCAL)

AUTHORITY	<p>The Superintendent or designee is authorized to accept or reject any transfer requests, provided that such action is without regard to race, religion, color, sex, disability, national origin, or ancestral language.</p> <p>A resident student who becomes a nonresident during the course of a semester shall be permitted to continue in attendance for the remainder of the semester and may be subject to applicable tuition.</p> <p>A resident student who becomes a nonresident after his or her junior year of high school may be allowed to complete the student's senior year in the District by submitting an out-of-District transfer application. The student may be subject to tuition.</p>
TRANSFER REQUESTS	<p>A nonresident student wishing to transfer into the District shall file an application for transfer each school year with the Superintendent or designee. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time.</p>
FACTORS	<p>In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider District enrollment, availability of space, instructional staff, and the student applicant's disciplinary history, academic records, and attendance records.</p>
TRANSFER AGREEMENTS	<p>A transfer student shall be notified in the written transfer agreement that he or she must follow all rules and regulations of the District. Violation of the terms of the agreement may result in a transfer request not being approved the following year.</p>
TUITION	<p>If the District charges tuition, the amount shall be set by the Board, within statutory limits.</p>
NONPAYMENT	<p>The District may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.</p>
APPEALS	<p>Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.</p>
