As you may be aware, on February 27, 2018 there was an incident at Robstown Early College High School involving an alleged threat made by a student. Once reported, the Robstown Police Department was immediately notified and the high school was placed on lockdown. The lockdown lasted approximately one and a half hours. Local law enforcement found no weapons and determined students were not in any immediate danger.

Amidst the uncertainty and tension that are part of the recent tragic events in Florida, we want to assure you that our schools are taking appropriate precautionary measures to ensure safety for all faculty, staff, and students. Each school has an emergency preparedness plan in place for emergency situations. This was executed according to plan this afternoon at Robstown Early College High School, and all staff members worked to respond appropriately.

To provide parental piece of mind, please know our schools are among the safest places for your children to be. Schools are a priority to receive emergency services from police, fire and other agencies.

In the meantime, it is our intent to continue with our daily business of caring for and educating the children of our community. As always, if you have any school-related concerns, please discuss these with your campus principal.
