<p>To be promoted to the 9th grade</p>	<p>No more than 10 unexcused absences</p>	<p>Meet the minimum requirements on the Georgia Milestone test.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Law requires that in order to be promoted to the 9th grade, a student must meet the following requirements: • Earn “On/Above Grade Level” on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in reading. • Earn an achievement level of “Developing Learner”, “Proficient Learner”, or “Distinguished Learner” on the math section of the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment. •
<p>To be promoted to the 10th grade and classified as a Sophomore:</p>	<p>No more than 10 unexcused absences in EACH course for the school year.</p>	<p>Student must have earned a total of 6 Carnegie units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 of the 6 units earned must be in English, Math, Social Studies or Science • 3 additional units in any other course (academic or elective)
<p>To be promoted to the 11th grade and classified as a Junior:</p>	<p>No more than 10 unexcused absences in EACH course for the school year.</p>	<p>Student must have earned a total of 12 Carnegie units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 of the 12 units earned must be in English, Math, Social Studies or Science • 6 additional units in any other course (academic or elective)
<p>To be promoted to the 12th grade and classified as a Senior:</p>	<p>No more than 10 unexcused absences in EACH course for the school year.</p>	<p>Student must have earned a total of 18 Carnegie units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 of the 18 units earned must be in English, Math, Social Studies or Science • 9 additional units in any other course (academic or elective)
