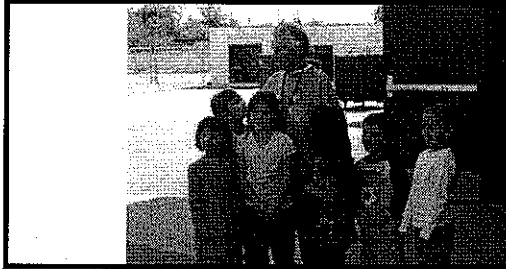

F. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS


1. Receive update on rescinding PKS notices in preparation of the 2011/2012 school year.
