Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)
SY 2018-2019

Students who choose to enroll in AP courses must understand and agree that:

- 1) AP is a *college level, *credit bearing course*, taught in high school. However, it is not a college course.
- 2) There is an expectation that **ALL** enrolled students **WILL PAY the AP Exam Fee by October 31, 2018** and **TAKE the AP exam at the end of the school-year in May.**
- 3) AP courses are computed on a 5-point grading scale giving students the opportunity to earn higher than a 4.0 GPA.
- 4) If students do not take the corresponding AP exams they will **forfeit the AP designation on their transcript** as well as the **5.0 weighted grading scale.**
- 5) AP courses are rigorous and will maintain *college level expectations and pace*. Students are expected to do approximately **1 hour of additional homework per day per AP course** outside the normal school day.
- 6) Summer work will be assigned in May of this school year (for new students enrolling, at the start of the school year). By not completing your summer assignment(s), the highest grade you can expect to earn in the first quarter of the course(s) is a "B."
- 7) Enrolling in AP is a choice and **should be done thoughtfully and with serious consideration to commitment.** Parents are **required to sign the Radford High School Registration card** and this **MOA** acknowledging that they, and their child, fully understand the rigors, requirements, and challenges of an AP course.
- 8) Current students (2017-18) enrolling for the 2018-19 SY will **not be allowed to drop** an AP course from their 2018-19 school schedules **after May 31, 2018**.
