

## ST. PATRICK SCHOOL UNIFORM CODE 2018-2019

Uniforms may be purchased at Liberty Shop, 404 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Meridian, MS 39301. The Recycle Shop is also available on campus for gently used items.

All students in grades PK-3 through 6<sup>th</sup> grade are required to wear school uniforms. Skorts, shorts and skirts should be at least fingertip length. If a child is not dressed in the appropriate uniform, a Uniform Violation Form will be sent home and/or parents will be called and expected to bring appropriate attire. Uniforms will consist of the following combinations:

### Daily Boys Uniform Prek- 6th

- **KHAKI** uniform shorts or pants (No extra side pockets or loops)
- White or green, long or short sleeve, school logo polo shirt
  - Undershirts that are worn must be white
  - No long sleeve shirts are allowed under short sleeve shirts
- Navy sweatshirts (with school logo) over uniform shirts

### Daily Girls Uniform PreK to 6<sup>th</sup> grade:

- Plaid skorts, skirts or shorts
- **KHAKI** uniform long pants (No extra side pockets or loops)
- White or green long or short sleeve school logo polo shirts
- Navy sweatshirts (with school logo) over uniform shirts
  - Undershirts that are worn must be white
  - No long sleeve shirts are allowed under short sleeve shirts

## MASS/ SPECIAL OCCASION APPAREL

### Girls Pre-k – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

- Plaid jumper
- Short or long sleeve white blouse with Peter Pan collar (no turtleneck or knit shirts)

### 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade

- **PLAID SKIRTS**
- **NO TUCK WHITE BLOUSE AND CROSS TIE BOW.**

### Boys Kindergarten to 6<sup>th</sup> grade

- Long **KHAKI** pants (No extra side pockets or loops)
- White Oxford button down (short or long sleeve)
- **NAVY AND GREEN STRIPED TIE (REGULAR STYLE OR BOW TIE)**

### **Accessories:**

**Jackets:** We do not have a specific jacket that must be worn to and from school; however, all jackets, sweaters, etc. worn inside the building must bear the school logo.

**Sweatshirts:** Solid navy blue only, with school logo

- Belts:** Must be solid brown leather. PK-3 and PK-4 should NOT wear belts with uniform. Only small, basic belt buckles will be allowed. Glitzy or super-size buckles are not allowed.
- Socks:** White or navy (ankle, knee, or tights for winter)
- Leggings:** Girls may wear solid navy or white leggings during the cold months only with a skort, skirt or jumper. The leggings should be long enough to meet the socks so that no skin is showing between the two.
- Hair:** All hair accessories must be white, navy, Kelly green, uniform plaid, or tortoise shell/brown.
- Sweaters:** Solid navy cardigans, with school logo
- Shoes:** **Athletic Shoes.** Students will be allowed to wear athletic shoes of choice. The main body of the shoes must be brown, blue, black, white, gray, green, or a combination of these colors. No flashing lights, glitter, sparkles, attachments or graffiti design allowed and must have closed heel and toe.

**Shoes Other than Athletic.** Students will be allowed to wear shoes other than athletic. However, they must be brown, blue, black, white, tan, gray, green, or a combination of these colors and must have closed heel and toe.

**Boots:** Low- heeled boots will be permitted for girls and boys. Boots should hit below the knee. Boys may only wear boots with pants un-tucked. Girls may wear boots with skorts or skirts not with shorts. No cowboy or pointed boots are allowed. Boots will only be allowed in brown, black, white, or gray.

**Shoe Laces:** Laces may be any color as long as they are a solid color.

For safety reasons all shoes must cover feet completely. No multiple laces are allowed, and laces should be able to be tied. No sandals, open-toed, open-heeled, open-sided, high-heeled, clog style, sport toe shoes will be allowed at school.

Velcro shoes are highly recommended for students who have not yet learned to tie laces.

- Jewelry:** **Girls:** Pierced earrings will be allowed; earrings should be small and not hang below the ear lobe.  
**Boys:** No pierced earrings allowed.  
**All students:** No other type of body piercing allowed for any student.  
**Pre-K students:** No watches allowed due to the distraction they represent.
- Makeup:** Students may not wear makeup, or artificial nails to school. No visible tattoos allowed.
- Hair Styles:** Hair colored, cut or styled in a manner that draws attention to it is not allowed.  
**Boy's hair** must not cover eyebrows or collar and should not be taller than 3 inches.  
**Girl's hair** should be styled in a manner so as not to obstruct vision.

The principal is the final judge in matters of hair.

**Uniforms:** All students should be clean and well groomed for school each day, and shirts must remain tucked in clothing.

**Mass Uniforms:** All students will wear Mass uniforms each week to Thursday Mass.

**Uniforms should not have holes, rips, or stains, and should fit properly.**

**Spirit Friday:**

Every Friday, students may wear a St. Patrick School spirit t-shirt with uniform bottoms.

**Jeans for Green Day:**

On the last Friday of each month, students may wear blue jean pants, shorts, or skirts for a \$1 donation to charity. Jeans should be free of holes. Blue jean leggings, jeggings, or tight jeans should not be worn. Denim skirts and shorts should be at least fingertip length.

**Uniform Free Day:**

Uniform Free Day is a privilege given to students for various specified occasions. The student is exempt from wearing his/her school uniform that day. The following are guidelines for appropriate clothing:

- All shirts must have sleeves and must cover the mid-section.
- Earrings for girls must follow uniform guidelines.
- Shoes must follow the uniform dress guidelines except for colors.
- Clothing should not bear symbols or wording that would be inappropriate in a Christian elementary school.
- The principal will make final decisions on appropriate dress.
