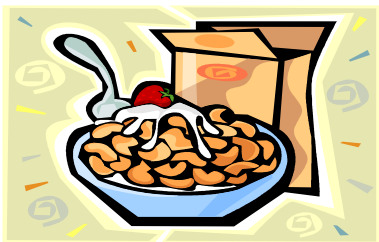
START, the before and after school enrichment program is currently accepting applications. There is no charge for this program but space is limited. Please stop by the office and
