School Messenger will not only have the capability of doing attendance, but on a larger scale, it will allow us to send documents, notices, lunch balance reminders and more. (Also the ability to mail in your school fees and receive your schedule before school starts.) Kaiser will be sending out your Summer Mail Out via Post and School Messenger via email. So, it's important to have your email addresses updated.
