

## **Student Parking Policy**

Students who use cars for transportation to and from school are expected to comply with the following guidelines. Violations of any of the following may result in a citation and processed through the KHSD police department or local BPD.

- 1.** Respect the parking lot, other cars, pedestrians, and, most importantly, drive safely. Obey all posted signs – 5 MPH speed limit.
- 2.** **Frontier High School is a closed campus during lunch. Any student caught cutting during the lunch hour can receive a two day suspension or other disciplinary action.**
- 3. *All vehicles parked on Frontier Campus are subject to being searched at any time.***
- 4.** Cars parked in the Frontier student parking lot are only to be driven when arriving or leaving school.
- 5.** Under special circumstances a student needs to have permission from the Dean's Office if they need access to their car in the student parking lot during the regular school day.
- 6.** No loitering in the parking lots.
- 7. Parking in the student parking lot is a privilege, not a right, and this privilege can be revoked if any of the above rules are not observed.**
