

Frequently Asked Questions

EZ-EFT

Q. WHAT IS EZ-EFT?

A. EZ-EFT or Electronic Funds Transfer is a paperless alternative to writing checks. You simply pre-authorize your payments to be made automatically and electronically by your financial institution (from your checking or savings account).

Q. WHAT DOES THIS PROGRAM OFFER ME?

A. It allows you to make your payments automatically without having to remember and write checks, each month. EZ-EFT payments happen each month, every time.

Q. WHAT DOES THIS SERVICE COST?

A. It doesn't cost you anything. You receive all these benefits absolutely free.

Q. WHY SHOULD I USE THIS SERVICE?

A. For convenience. This process saves our customers time and money. It also helps us control our costs, and we pass the savings on to you.

Q. HOW DO I KNOW MY PAYMENTS WILL BE MADE ON TIME?

A. This service is provided by **SafeSave**, the nation's leading provider of Electronic Funds Transfer. They guarantee automatic processing of your payment to assure proper application of funds in your account.

Q. HOW WILL I KNOW WHEN MY PAYMENT IS GOING TO BE TRANSFERRED FROM MY ACCOUNT?

The transfer dates are listed on your monthly invoices. They are scheduled for the first Friday of the month. There are some instances where this date may slightly deviate and your invoice will reflect accordingly.

Q. HOW WILL I KNOW MY PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE?

Your payment is clearly itemized on your bank statement and will also be posted on your next monthly statement for receipt purposes, flexible spending documentation and Tax purposes.

Q. WHO HAS ACCESS TO MY ACCOUNTS?

A. No one but you and your financial institution. To use EZ-EFT, you authorize your financial institution to make the payments. Your financial institution automatically makes your payment on your behalf, but only with your authorization. Consumer safeguards for EZ-EFT make it more secure than conventional payments.
