



History of Park View School

1955	Park View School opens its doors with an enrollment of a little more than 100 students, four teachers and five classrooms.
1957	School opens with a new addition. There are now eight classrooms. Mr. Dale Hosler becomes the first principal.
1961	Another addition is added on to Park View School.
1972	Park View now has 15 classrooms, a full time Resource teacher, a part-time Kindergarten teacher and about 455 students.
1987	Mr. Kim Perkins becomes the second principal.
1990	Mrs. Sandra Dressler becomes the third principal.
1991	The roof collapses over the LRC but is repaired in time for school to open. Park View opens as a K-5 building; 6th graders move to Glenn Westlake Middle School.
2000	Another addition is completed which doubles the size of the school.
2005	Park View School celebrates 50 years of excellence.
2008	Mrs. Roberta Wallerstedt becomes the fourth principal.
2009-2013	Park View is awarded the 'Academic Excellence' award by the state of Illinois each year.
2014	Park View School is awarded it's first Blue Ribbon Award by the U.S. Department of Education under the category of 'Exemplary High Performing'.
2015	Park View School was recognized as one of '50 Inspiring Schools Meeting the Challenge' in the United States by thebestschools.org.
