In the coming year, the State of California will be changing how it funds public schools. Lloyde High School will be affected by the changes to the funding process, which is called the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), and requires parental involvement in planning and decision-making. This plan also shifts spending decisions from the State to our District, requiring Lloyde High School to focus on eight key areas to help students succeed. Additionally, it provides extra funding for students with specific challenges, and provides more flexibility as to how we can improve our school.

The eight areas of focus for success are:

- School Climate
- Student Achievement
- Student Engagement
- Other School Outcomes
- Parental Involvement
- Course Access
- Implementation of Common Core Standards
- Basic Services

Your responsibility will be in the development of our Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), which ensures student academic success and social growth.
