Discussion and review of Comprehensive Needs Assessment	I/D	Council will review Comprehensive Needs Assessment-The CNA report looked at data on 4 areas: demographics, perception, student learning, and processes at KMS to serve as the foundation for a school-wide plan for improvement. The report identifies common challenges to be addressing the school's achievement gap, holding teachers accountable to efficiently and consistently following the PDCA model, improving home-school communication and relationships, and the ART to lead and support staff in adhering to the Academic Plan. Three areas of focus are to design and implement a comprehensive RTI plan, the ART to lead the school in a consistent implementation of learning systems, and the school to improve its role in the community as a place for rigorous learning. Discussion and review of Academic Plan	I/D	Council will review Academic Plan-KMS's Academic Plan for improvement consists of 5 main strategies and an additional 3 optional ones. KMS will focus on full implementation and common learning expectations for the Hawaii Common Core Standards, implementation of a system of supports to address needs of all students to include the RTI program and intervention and corrective services, administration and staff use of formative instruction and the data team process, support and evaluation of teachers through the Educator Effectiveness System, and support and mentoring of new teachers. Additional optional strategies include communication and articulation of high expectations for achievement to all stakeholders in K-12, adopting and acquiring AVID beliefs and strategies at KMS, and to fulfill the mission to build partnerships with students, families, and the community to educate and empower our children.
