This is an important message from King School:

An enthusiastic thank you to the parents, family members, and after school care providers who consistently follow our parking lot rules. Everyone knows that a trip through the King parking lot is frustrating and stressful at times, especially on rainy or early release days. These traffic nightmares and delays can be avoided if everyone follows the procedures outlined below, as most of you have been doing. The greatest impact to an orderly trip through the parking lot occurs when someone does not follow the parking lot safety rules. This creates a backup for many onto Moody Street, or unsafe situations in the parking lot.

Please take a moment to review the following parking lot tips:

1. The entrance into the parking lot is at the light. The exit is the next driveway.
2. Do not pull into or block, even for a brief time, a handicapped parking spots (unless you have a placard) or unmarked areas.
3. Your child may only enter or exit your vehicle after you have pulled as far forward as possible in the loading zone and when you are safely stopped against the yellow curb. Children must exit the vehicle on side that faces the sidewalk, not the parking lot.
4. When walking from the parking lot, all visitors and students at King School must use the blue crosswalk to get to the sidewalk.
5. When walking to school, all students and visitors must walk behind the safety fence or along the sidewalk into the courtyard. Students are not allowed to “short-cut” through the middle of the parking lot as this is not safe.
6. Park in a marked parking stall only.
7. Please do not exit at the light through the parking lot entrance on Merten Ave.
8. Children will not be escorted into the street for pick-up.

With everyone’s cooperation, visiting the parking lot can mean a much more tolerable experience and set the tone for a positive school day and/or afternoon.
