K-12 Japanese Language Program

Culver City Unified School District is proud to offer a K-12 Japanese Language Program, a specialized instructional program with the goal of graduating global students with Advanced levels of Japanese Language Proficiency. Students begin the program in a Two-Way Japanese Dual Language Program at El Marino Language School. These students continue their language instruction in Culver City Middle School where they are offered every year a content-based academic Japanese elective course. Through their studies of Japanese culture and history, these courses aim at developing students’ Japanese literacy skills. The Japanese Language program continues up to Culver City High School where students have the option to advance through the Japanese program at an accelerated pace. Students who meet the criteria complete their Japanese studies by the end of their Sophomore year. Through the K-12 Japanese Language Program, Culver City Unified School District aims to graduate students with Advanced levels of Japanese.
