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Deadline: Weds. April 6th, 2016. Note: Seniors must pay in cash starting March 28th.

Cost: Pay at the finance office: \$83 per exam full price or \$12 per exam for students that qualify for a fee waiver.

Fee Waivers: (2 ways to qualify)

- 1) Students with free/reduced lunch. See Mrs. McGee in the counseling office **BEFORE** school to pick up your slip. She arrives at Ridgeview at 7:30 AM each morning.
- 2) Students whose household income does not exceed 185 percent of the federal poverty income guidelines (see table below). Pick up the necessary forms from Mrs. McGee, before school or Ms. Huntington (office, room 906)
