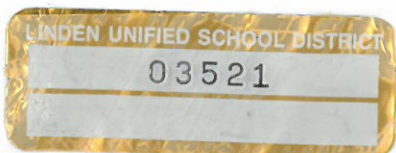

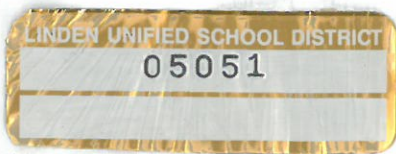
The high school would like to dispose of the following equipment:

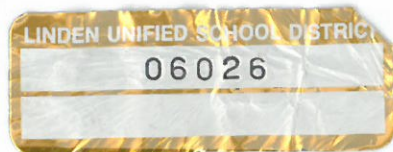
