For the past several years, St. Anthony School has partnered with Poverty Bay Coffee Company to make available "Roadrunner Coffee."

Poverty Bay is a small-batch micro-roaster in Seattle. Their coffees are shade-grown, 100% sustainable and purchased from the farmers at a price that exceeds Fair Trade Coffee standards.

With every purchase of their coffee, \$2.50 is donated to the Father Lane Endowment Fund, which goes directly to funding Tuition Assistance at St. Anthony School.

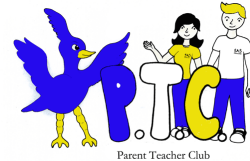

Thank you to everyone who volunteered and attended the Tailgate Party in September. It was a great success.

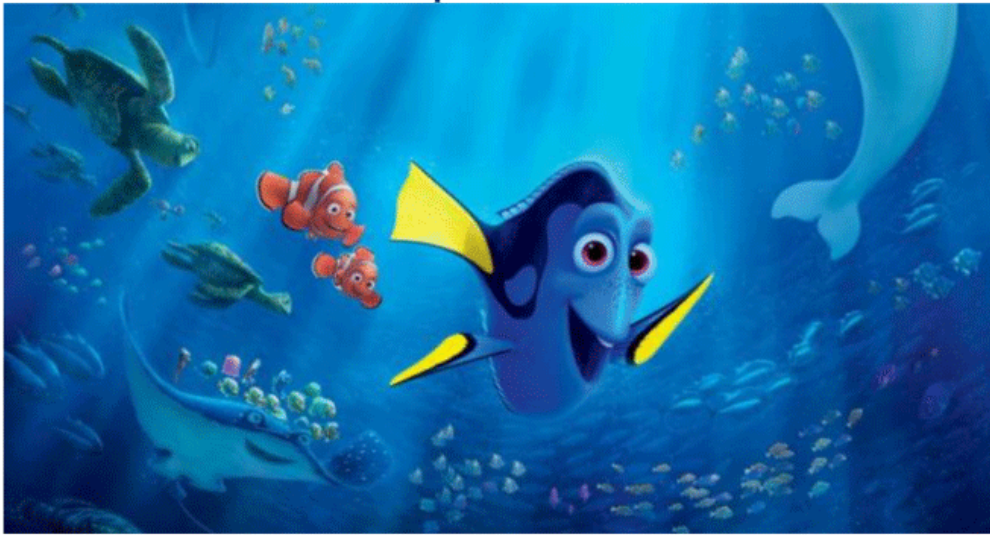

## Student Essay Contest

Open to Catholic-school students grades K-12

NORTHWEST CATHOLIC is holding its fifth annual student essay contest. The three first-place essays, with photos of the authors, will be published in the January/February 2018 issue of NORTHWEST CATHOLIC.

The contest is open to students enrolled in Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Seattle. Essays should answer the following question: **"How can you share Jesus with others?"** Word limits are as follows: grades K-5: 250 words; grades 6-8: 350 words; grades 9-12: 500 words.

Essays will be judged on content, creativity and mechanics (organization, grammar, spelling). Most importantly: Be authentic. Don't be boring.

**Essays must be received by October 12**

will receive \$150.**

Plus a \$500 grant for the  
teacher of his or her choice.

Entries should include the student's name, contact email address, school name (and city), and grade level. Note: If the contest is used as an all-class or all-school assignment, teachers should choose up to three essays from each class to enter. Individual entries are welcome.
