- I. **Call to Order:** 3:35 pm by Dr. Yoon (late start due to having to wait for members to show up to have a quorum)

- III. **Approval of Minutes:** September 22, 2016 minutes unanimously approved

- IV. **New Business**
 - a. **ACTION ITEM:** It was moved and seconded that on Tuesday, November 1, 2016, teachers be allowed, on a volunteer basis, to escort their classes to the field by 2:30 pm to participate in the yearbook cover photo. Motion passed unanimously. Due to cancellation of Friday's Homecoming Game against Locke, yearbook wanted to schedule a crowd shot to be used on the front cover of the 2017 yearbook.

 - b. **ACTION ITEM:** It was moved and seconded to switch the early dismissal date set up for December 16, 2016 to take place on Friday, November 4th instead, in order to accommodate the new Homecoming Game scheduled for November 4th at 2:30. A concern was raised about the talent show originally planned for the October 28th game night, that perhaps it could be held in December.

 - c. **ACTION ITEM:** The Open House action item was tabled after discussion. Discussion revolved around whether to hold open house on April 20th or 27th, from 5:00 to 7:00 pm or from 6:00 to 8:00 pm and whether the format used last year actually was better. It was agreed that parents would be surveyed at the next Coffee with the Principal and the results brought to the next LC meeting for consideration.

- d. **Overview of instructional program at LA High:** Dr. Yoon and Dr. Searchwell (APSCS), presented information regarding the sunseting of SIG funds this year and its dramatic impact on LA High's instructional program, credit recovery opportunities, and its ability to draw new students to LA High. It was agreed that this information had to be brought to the larger school audience with the opportunity for smaller groups to discuss and set forth strategies and recommendations for moving forward.
