

Meads Mill “Peer-2-Peer” Program

After-School Peer Helping Program

The Meads Mill “Peer-2-Peer” Program is an after-school program for 6th grade students to seek help from an 8th grade student. The 8th grade students are volunteering his or her skills and to help their younger peers be more successful in middle school.

Program Objectives

- To provide an opportunity for students to receive one-on-one or small group assistance on organization, an academic skill, or homework assignment from a peer helper.
- To improve a student’s understanding of academic responsibility and work/study habits.
- To develop student communication skills and social development.

Program Outcomes

- Students will learn and develop organizational skills.
- Student’s completion of homework assignments will increase.
- Students will develop greater self-confidence and self-efficacy when completing assigned work.
- A school culture will develop where students feel supported by their peers.
- Student tutors will gain experience as a leader among their peers.

How do I sign-up for help from “Peer-2-Peer”?

- Students must complete a registration form to receive assistance from a peer helper. This form can be found in the counseling office. It must be returned to the counselor before a student can attend the after-school program.

How can I become a peer helper?

- 8th grade students who are interested in volunteering as a peer helper should ask their counselor for an application and teacher recommendation form. Once both forms are complete, students should return them to his or her counselor.
- Peer tutors are required to participate in three training sessions prior to working with other students. These training sessions will review their role as a peer tutor and teach them communication/helping skills to help them be effective when working with other students.

Peer-2-Peer is not an after-school latchkey program. It is only for students requesting academic assistance.
