

Board of Education Member from New Hanover

It shall be the policy of the Bordentown Regional Board of Education to provide to the New Hanover Board of Education representation on the Bordentown Regional Board of Education, as per the requirements of N.J.S.A. 18A:38-8.2.

If the pupils of New Hanover School District comprise less than 10% of the total enrollment of the pupils in grades 9 through 12 of the Bordentown Regional School District, the New Hanover seat on the Bordentown Board is subject to the following conditions:

1. It will be a non-voting seat.
2. The appointment will be of one specific New Hanover Board member selected by the New Hanover Board and will be on an annual basis from one organization meeting to the next.
3. The New Hanover representative will be able to address any aspect of the agenda related to the Bordentown Regional High School.
4. The New Hanover representative will not be able to attend any meeting, or portion thereof, that is closed to the public unless specifically invited by the Bordentown Regional Board.
5. The New Hanover representative will receive all of the communication received by the other Bordentown Regional Board members except those communications deemed to be confidential under the Public Meetings Act.

If the pupils of New Hanover School District comprise more than 10% of the total enrollment of the pupils in the grades 9 through 12 of the Bordentown Regional School District, New Hanover shall have one representative on the Bordentown Regional Board with voting ability on the following areas:

1. Appointments, transfers or removal of teaching staff members providing services to pupils of the New Hanover District;
2. Development, revision and implementation of policies;
3. Election of Board of Education officers;
4. Approval of professional consultants, such as solicitor, school physician, architect of record, etc.;
5. Curriculum, text books, and instructional materials utilized by students in grades 9 through 12;
6. Addition or deletion of extracurricular programs involving pupils of the New Hanover District;
7. New capital construction to be utilized by the New Hanover students.
