

Chromebook Checkout

All Bowie students are required to bring a device with a 10"+ screen to school every day. Most of the students' textbooks and many other classroom materials will only be available in a digital format for which a smartphone is not adequate, so devices are a MUST. Students may bring their personal device or can checkout a Chromebook. The device will be checked out to the student until the student is not enrolled in Austin ISD or asked to be returned by a campus administrator. Chromebooks are provided to students for free as part of the AISD Everyone:1 program (go to the following website for more information <https://www.austinisd.org/technology/help>).

STEPS TO CHECKOUT A CHROMEBOOK:

1. PARENT - A Chromebook parent consent form must be submitted before a device will be issued to the student. To access the online consent form:
 - Go to the AISD Parent Cloud (my.austinisd.org) and log-in
 - Type "consent" into the search tool to locate the "Everyone:1 Device Consent" icon
 - Submit the digital consent form

Note: Parents who do not have a Parent Cloud account must pick up a hard-copy of the consent form in the Bowie main office or print it from the website noted above
2. STUDENT – Once the consent form has been submitted by your parent
 - Sign-up for a FIT session with Ms. Theis to pick-up their Chromebook
 - Add yourself to Bowie's Chromebook course in BLEND, using this link: <http://bit.ly/bowiechromebook>. Complete the two parts of the course: (1) Digital Citizenship, and (2) Chromebook Usage Training
 - If you have any problems with your Chromebook, sign up for a FIT session with Ms. Theis.
