TEACHER LOOK-A-LIKE DAY	Cadets will be able to <u>appropriately</u> dress up as the OMI Staff Member of their choice.	Upon uniform inspections, cadets must be able to properly identify themselves as the OMI Staff member of their choice that they are <u>appropriately</u> representing.
Tue 6FEB18	What to Wear	Notes/Activities
COMFY DAY	Cadets are authorized to wear any color sweatpants/joggers, pajama pants, onsies (with appropriate under garments), and shirts.	No halter, tank, tube, sheer, camisoles or lace up tops, under garments worn as outer wear, slides, sandals, slippers, or flip flops, excessively tight sweat pants/joggers, accessories, lingerie, shorts, robes
Wed 7FEB18	What to Wear	Activities/Notes
CARTOON DAY	Alternate Grizzly Dress Uniform with a character from any appropriate cartoon show subbing either the outer layer or inner layer uniform item.	Makeup is not allowed. Approved cartoons can come from the Fox Network, Disney, Warner Bros, Nickelodeon, or Bandai. Cadets must be able to properly identified themselves as their cartoon character of choice
Thu 8FEB	What to Wear	Activities/Notes
DECADES DAY	Cadets may wear any appropriate attire up to 2006. Cadets MUST wear their OMI ID to be considered in compliance.	Cadets are not authorized to wear ripped jeans, mini skirts, off the shoulder shirts, short shorts, spandex, crop/bandanna/ halter/tube/sheer/lace up tops, and graphic or inappropriate content for a school environment No accessories are allowed. Cadets must be able to properly identify themselves from the era of their choice.
