Benefits for Families and Students (SAVE BIG \$\$\$)

1. Each Dual Enrollment can be saving from \$700 to \$4500 per class including Books and Lab fees. These are classes that meet UC/CSU General Education Requirements for upper level course work. These Courses will receive College Credit from MSJC with a C or better!!!
2. Each AP Course can be an equivalent savings depending on the score received on AP test (3, 4, or 5). Again a huge Savings for your family and students. (Test must be taken to have an opportunity to receive college credit).
3. AP LANG/LIT can meet English entrance requirements for 4 year Colleges/Universities with a 3 or better on the Test. (No entrance Exam Fees)
4. AP Calc AB/AP Stats can meet Math entrance requirements for 4 year Colleges/Universities with a 3 or better on the AP Test. (No entrance Exam Fees)
5. Your students can walk into a four year college with up to two years completed in College Credits. This can be \$15,000 to \$60,000 savings. No student loans.

Dual Enrollment Overview

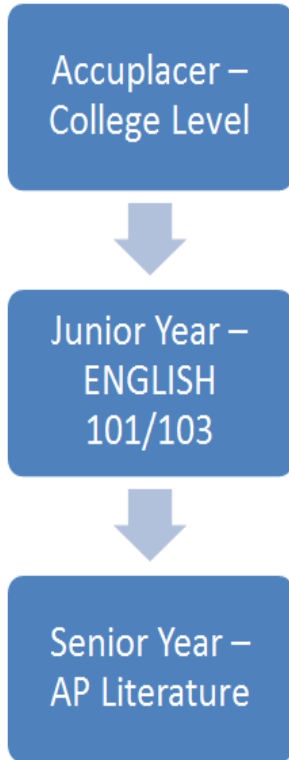
- Earn college credit and weighted high school credit
