



PREVENTION/EARLY INTERVENTION CLASSES

Point Break Adolescent Resources shall be, for the purposes of this agreement, an independent contractor and shall not be deemed an employee of Linden High School for any purpose.

Point Break Adolescent Resources will provide Prevention/Early Intervention Classes to students referred from Linden High School who are assigned to the class by the school counselors and/or administrators.

I. TERMS

1. The effective date of the agreement is August 1, 2013.
2. The service shall be provided to students referred during the 2013-2014 school year. If a student is referred prior to the end of the year, but attends the class during the summer, the invoice will be upon registration.

II. SERVICE TO BE PERFORMED

1. Point Break Adolescent Resources will provide the following prevention classes: Anger Management, Substance Abuse, and Gang Awareness.
2. Point Break will contact the referred student's family to establish a date for the student and parent(s) to register for the classes and complete an assessment.
3. Classes take place once a week for seven, eight, or nine weeks, depending upon the class
4. All students must attend all session to receive a certificate of completion. One absence is allowed, but it must be made up with an assignment. A parent or guardian will be required to attend 1-3 sessions, depending upon the class

III. PLACE OF PERFORMANCE

1. Point Break will provide the classes at the Point Break Office in Stockton - 1102 North School Street, 95205.

IV. COMPENSATION

1. Point Break Adolescent Resources shall be compensated from Linden High School: \$120.00 per student with payment due upon invoice.
