Talking points are brief highlights to share with faculty, staff, administration, FARHS Board members, President Advisory Board members, and Alumni to ensure clear and accurate details are shared.

WHAT IS FARHS?

According to its Articles of Incorporation as of August 13, 2012, Friends of Archbishop Ryan High School:

"is a corporation organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), specifically to: (i) to support Archbishop Ryan High School in Philadelphia in carrying out its mission to provide catholic education by encouraging fellowship among Alumni of Archbishop Ryan and by providing tuition assistance for students of Archbishop Ryan High School; and (ii) to take any and all actions necessary , proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of these purposes consistent with the limitations set forth in this Section and the provisions of Section 11 and Section 12 below. In furtherance of the foregoing, the Corporation shall have the power to do any acts and carry on any business and affairs that are not prohibited by the Act, as amended, by the Code, or by any other law."

Highlights:
