Dear Parents/Guardians,

- ✚ School supplies will be distributed to students who ordered on time over the summer on **September 5th**. Eight grade students received their materials/supplies this week. Families who ordered after the due date will receive their supplies as soon as they are available. All students will receive a school Agenda book next Tuesday. Please allot some time to review the student handbook with your child. It is located in the front of the agenda (book). This will allow you to get familiar with the expectations of our school.
- ✚ Summer school assignments are **due on Friday, September 8th**
- ✚ 8th grade students who are interested in attending a Catholic High School (TACH) or are interested in taking the Specialized High School Exam (SHSAT) – MVP is offering free prep courses to prepare for the exams. - ✚ We are awaiting notification from the organization managing the afterschool programs as to the starting date of the afterschool activities. We will notify you as soon as that programming is finalized.

- ✚ 8th grade parent meeting with Guidance Counselors on **Wednesday, September 27th**
- ✚ 8th grade students are arriving at school between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., which I think is admirable, however in order to ensure their safety upon arrival and to make that time productive, we are coordinating “before school programs” to enhance the instruction received during the day. The areas we are looking to strengthen is ELA and Math, and the time we are considering for the program to take place is, 7:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m., from Monday through Thursday (students can have breakfast from 7:00 a.m.-7:30 a.m.). **We will begin the program on Monday, September 11, 2017.**
- ✚ Due to scheduling and programming conflicts, we will be changing the dates/times for Speech and Debate. Details will be forthcoming.
