Mission Statement

History

Since 1904, Catholic of Pointe Coupee has provided its children with a religious, academic, and disciplined education. During this time there have always been other alternatives for acquiring an education in and around our area. The faith and dedication that our families have put in us over several generations, reinforces the success that we have achieved in striving for academic excellence.

Over the past several years we have improved the curriculum that our school offers, as well as repaired our existing facilities. While these recent events have helped enhance the educational experience at Catholic of Pointe Coupee, they are not enough. The time has come for us to raise capital funds, expand our campus, and ensure that we are able to provide the necessary resources for

our students today and for generations to come.

Through review of our long range plan by the administration, school advisory board, and advancement committee, it has been determined that facility improvements are necessary to continue building on the success of our past and addressing the needs of the future. Phase 1 of these plans includes a new multipurpose building, as well as repairs to our existing facilities.

Safety On Campus

The new facility will shift the main high school entry point from the middle of campus to the perimeter, which will allow us to effectively secure the back area of campus through new fencing and automated gates.

Gym/Auditorium

A new Gym/Auditorium will be included to help house events hosted by the school, benefit the elementary by providing a gathering place for them throughout the day, and to accommodate the demands of athletic events for both the elementary and high school.



Library/Media Center

Our current library is housed in the middle school building and serves our elementary students. By relocating our library to the new facility, we will not only enhance the experience for our elementary students, but we will also incorporate a new media/technology center for our upperclassmen. This will allow them to access and utilize the technology necessary in today's world.

Chapel

Housing a chapel on campus will provide a place for our students, faculty, and staff to gather in spiritual reflection, prayer, and worship on a daily basis.

Classroom Space

Increased enrollment and advanced curriculum opportunities bring the need for more classrooms. New science and technology lab spaces will be included to ensure that all students have access to the highest quality learning opportunities in science and technological subjects. The additional classrooms will also allow for the removal of the existing temporary buildings on campus.



Renovations To Facilities



Due to the age of our existing buildings, there is a need to upgrade and increase the efficiency of the mechanical and electrical systems throughout our entire campus. Exterior improvements will also be made to enhance the appearance and increase the energy efficiency of the buildings.



Overall Site Plan
