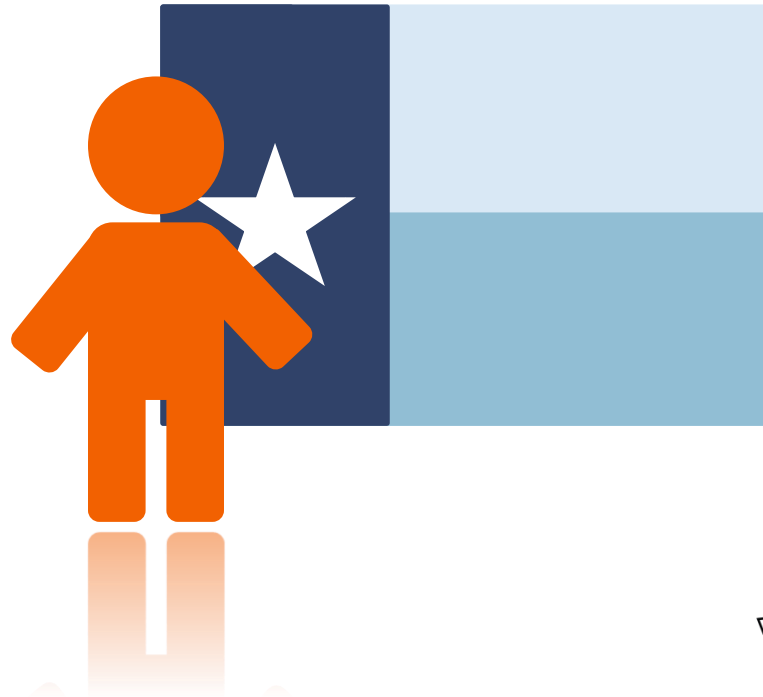

Annual Report

This report includes an overview of the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR), PEIMS Financial Standard Reports, district accreditation status, campus performance objectives, violent or criminal incidents report, and information received from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) for West High School.

TAPR Overview

- Due to changes in legislation, the performance report formerly known as the Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) report is now the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR).
- AEIS was published from 1990-91 to 2011-12. Archived AEIS reports may be found on the AEIS Archives page through TEA.
- The TAPR provides information on the performance of students in each school and district in Texas. The reports also provide extensive information on school and district staff, programs, and student demographics.

New for 2017

- **STAAR Performance Level Descriptors** - STAAR results are categorized as Approaches Grade Level, Meets Grade Level, or Masters Grade Level.
- **Inclusion of 2016 STAAR Data** - STAAR data for 2016 is included to allow for direct comparisons of 2016 to 2017. The 2015–16 TAPR included only one year of data.

New for 2017 continued...

- **Student Success Initiative (SSI)** - The SSI grade-advancement requirement was suspended for the 2015–16 school year, and the June administrations of STAAR for grade 5 and grade 8 were cancelled. As a result, the following data have been removed for both reading and mathematics.
 - STAAR Non-Proficient Students Promoted by Grade Placement Committee
 - STAAR Met Standard (Not Proficient in Previous Year)
 - Promoted to Grade 6 or 9
 - Retained in Grade 5 or 8

New for 2017 continued...

- **Participation** - STAAR participation data for 2016 is included to allow for comparisons of 2016 to 2017
- **Graduation Rate** Lines have been added that indicate the 6-year extended federal graduation rate without exclusions for the Class of 2014 and the Class of 2013.
- **Profile** - Lines have been added that indicate the counts and percentages of students with disabilities. These counts are disaggregated by type of primary disability.
- **Mobility** - Lines have been added that indicate the mobility rate by race/ethnicity.
- **Staff Information** - Lines have been added that indicate the average years of experience of campus leadership.

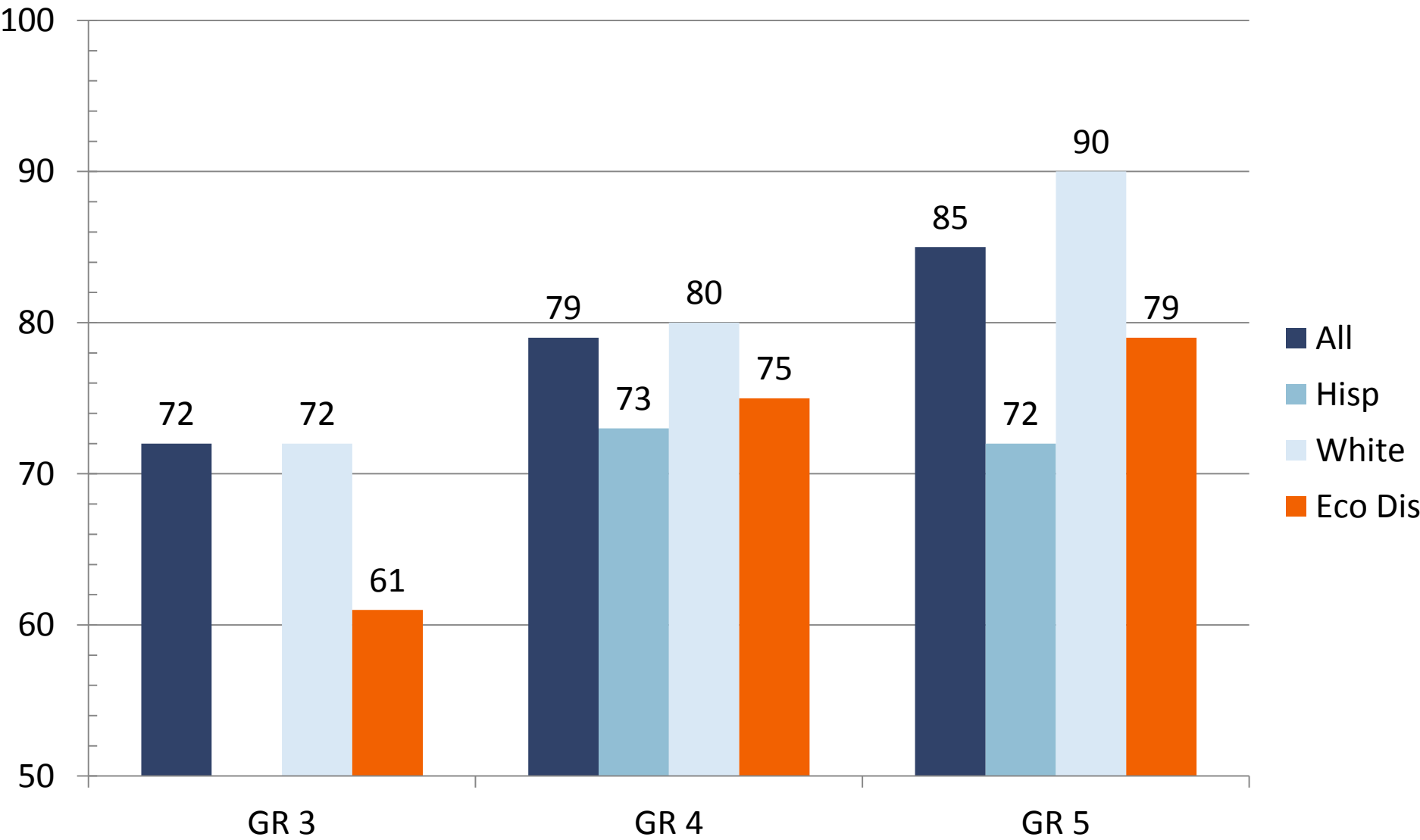

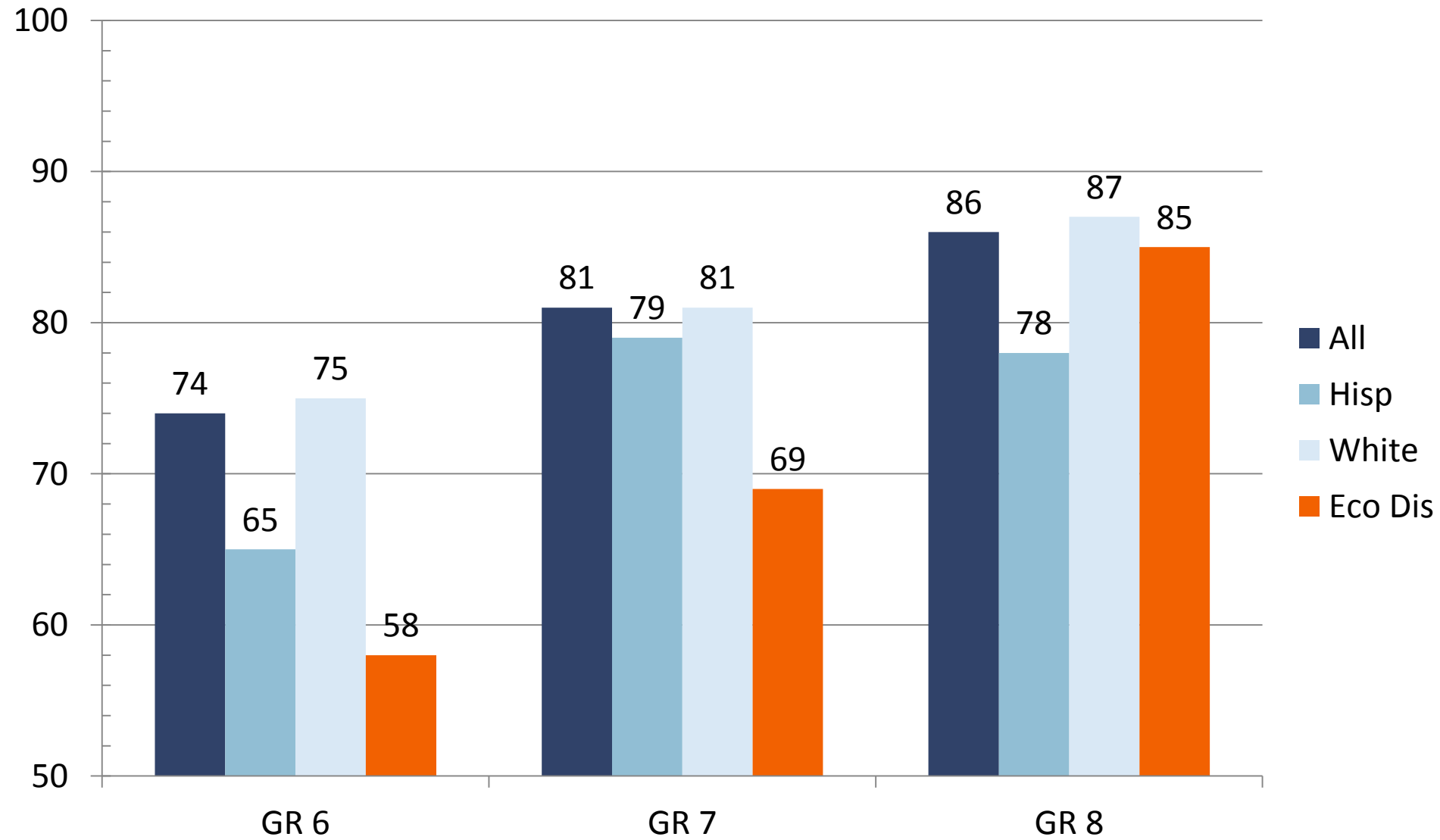
2016 STAAR 3-5 Reading Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above

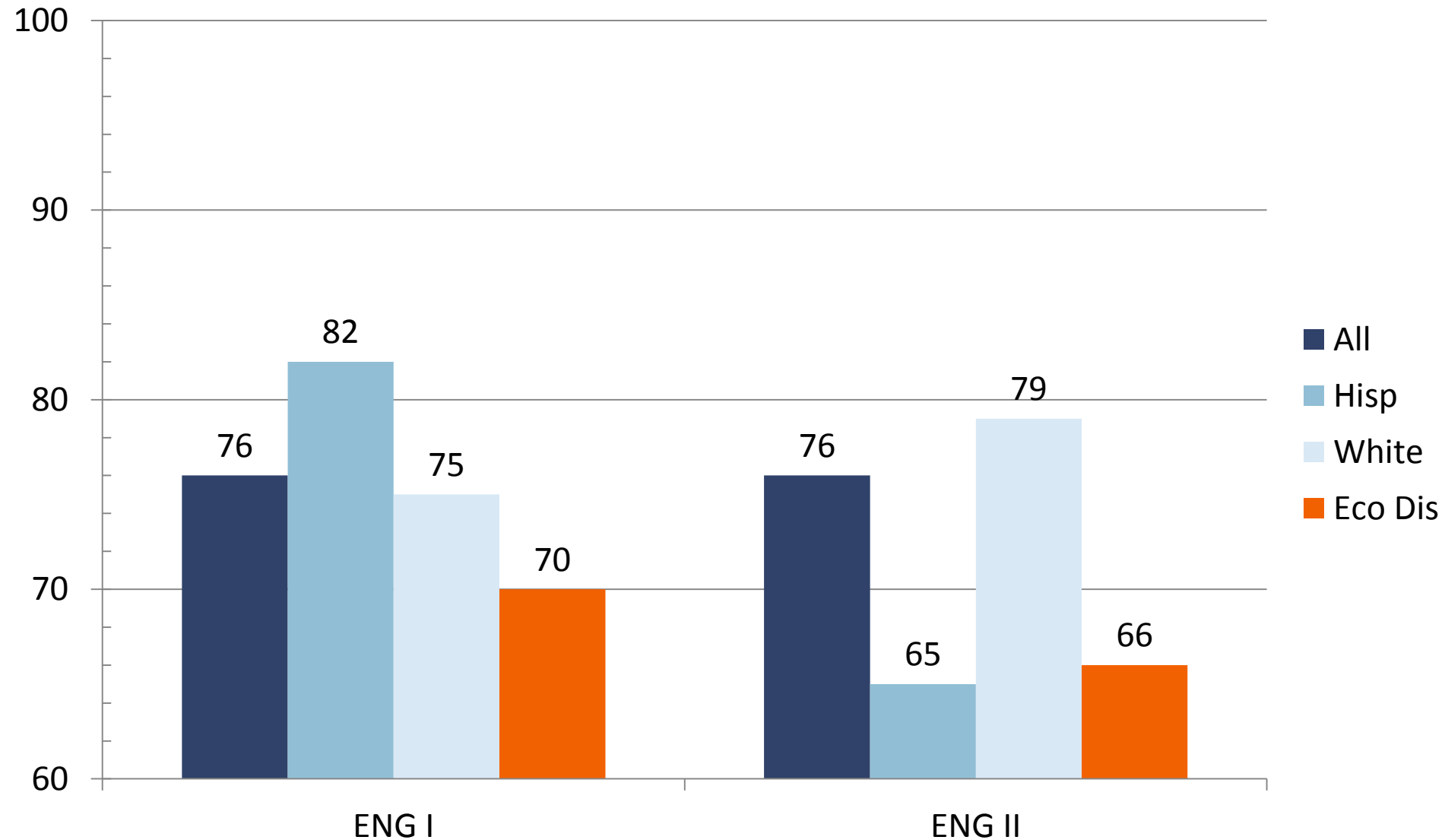


2016 STAAR 6-8 Reading Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above

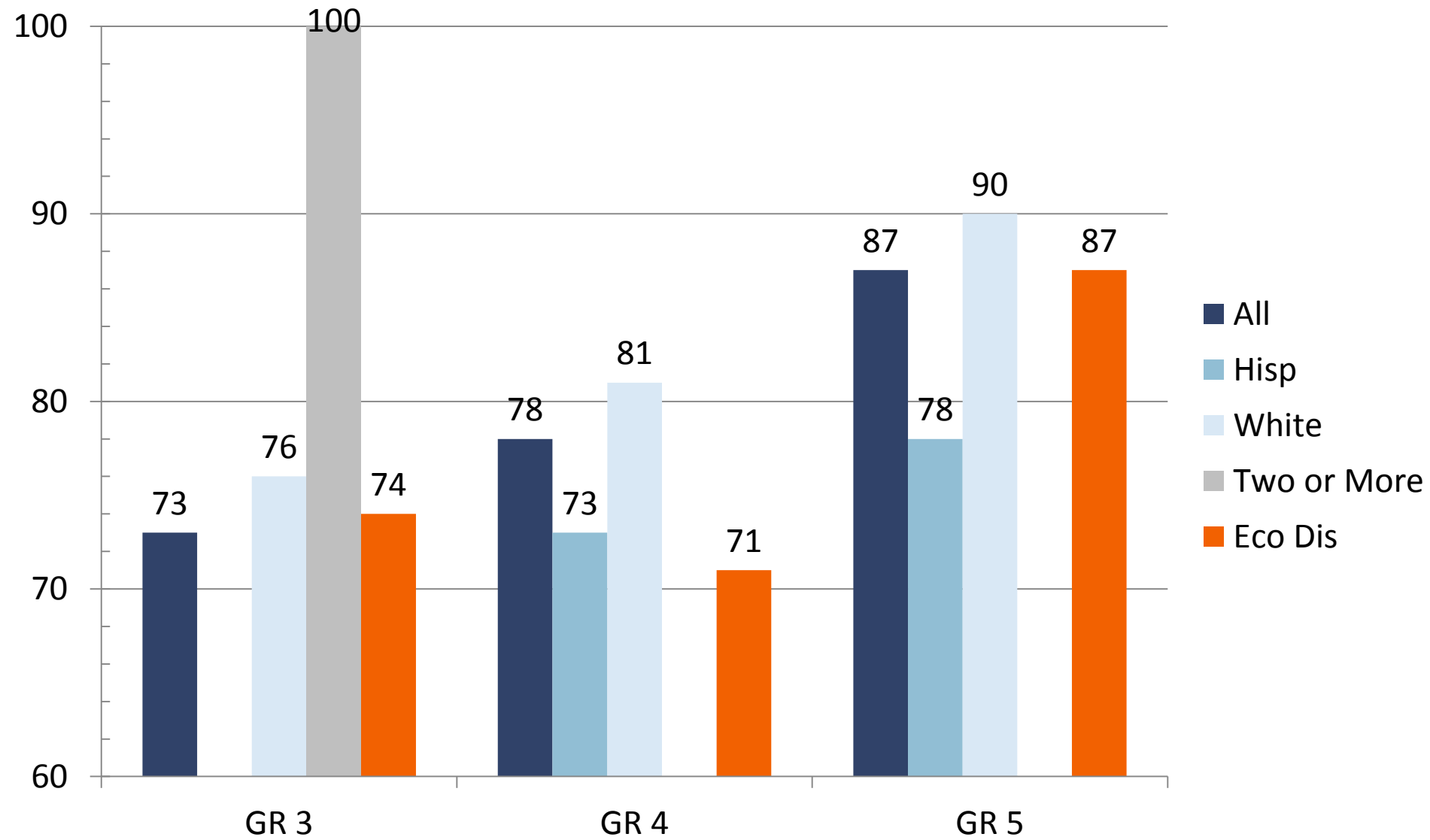


2016 STAAR End-of-Course: English Language Arts Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



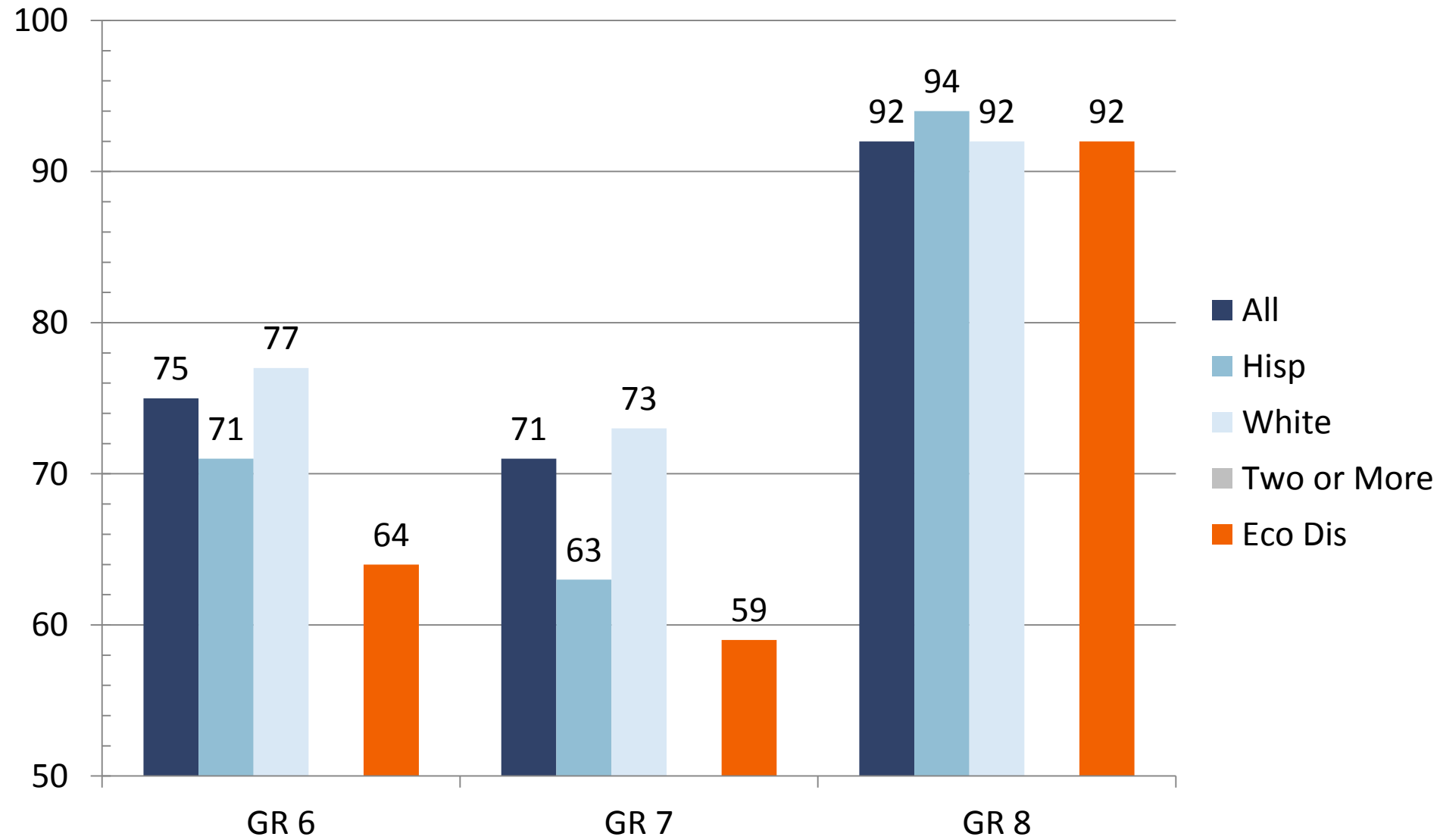
2016 STAAR 3-5 Mathematics Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



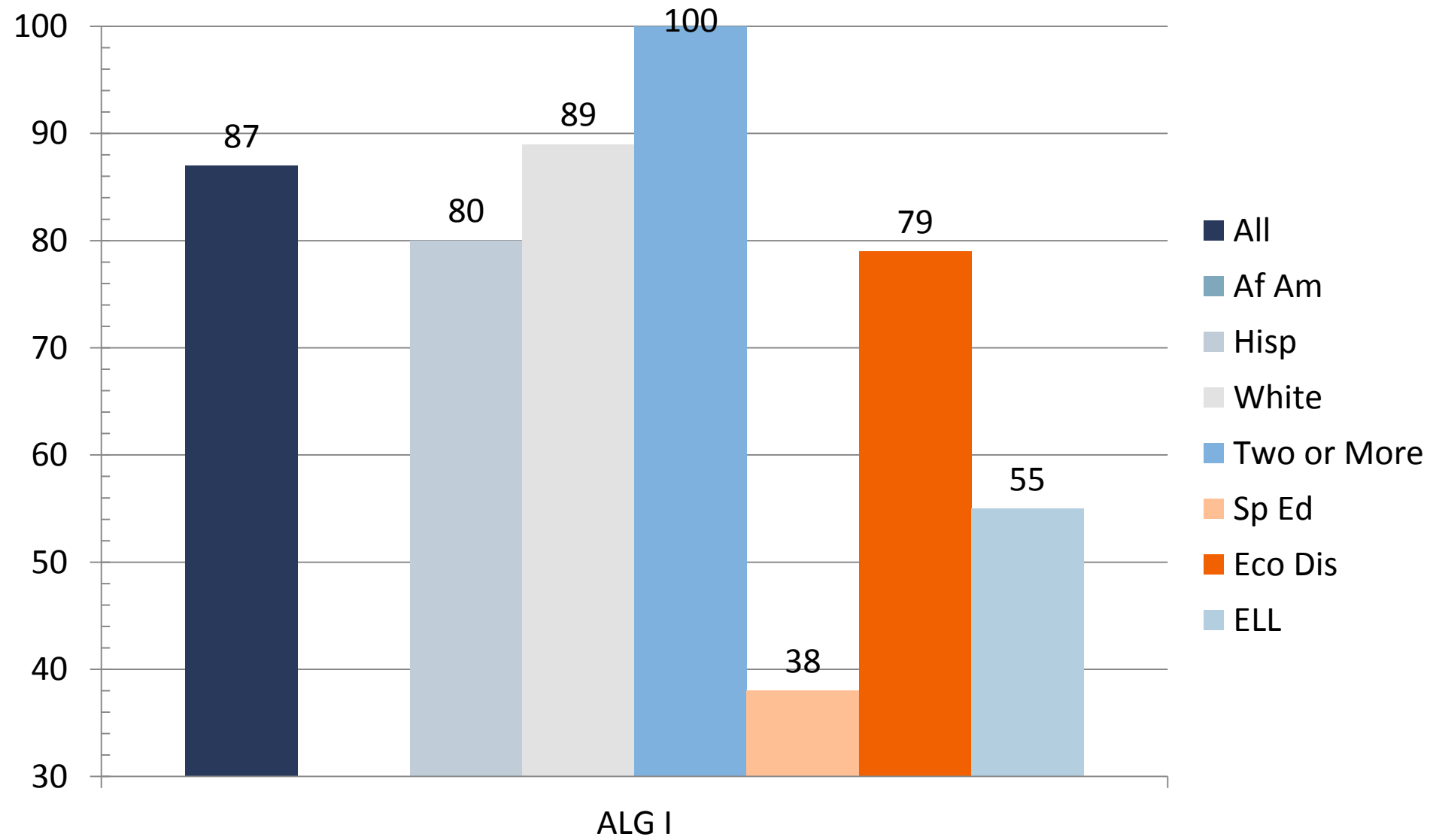
2016 STAAR 6-8 Mathematics Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



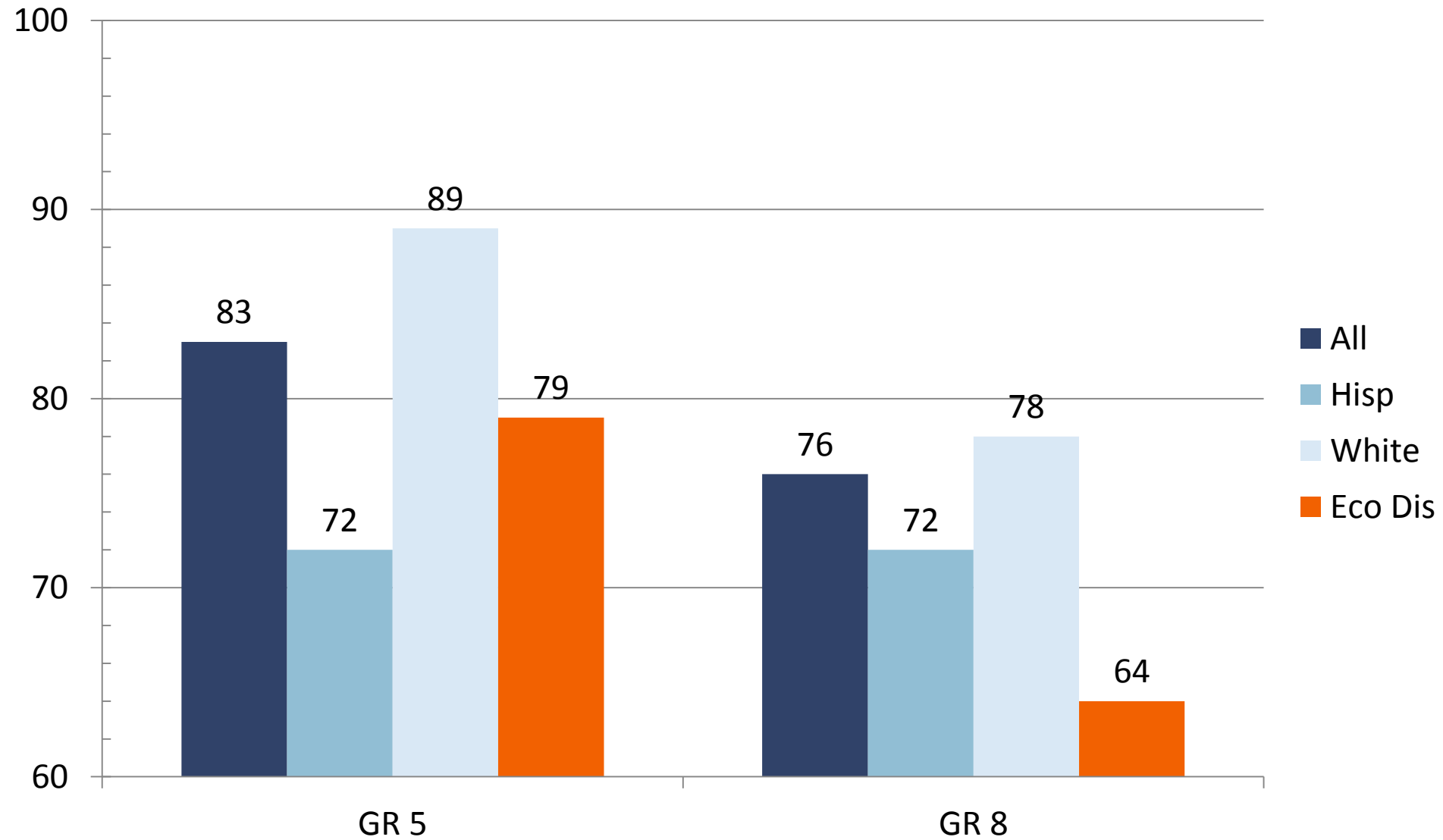
2016 STAAR End-of-Course: Mathematics

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



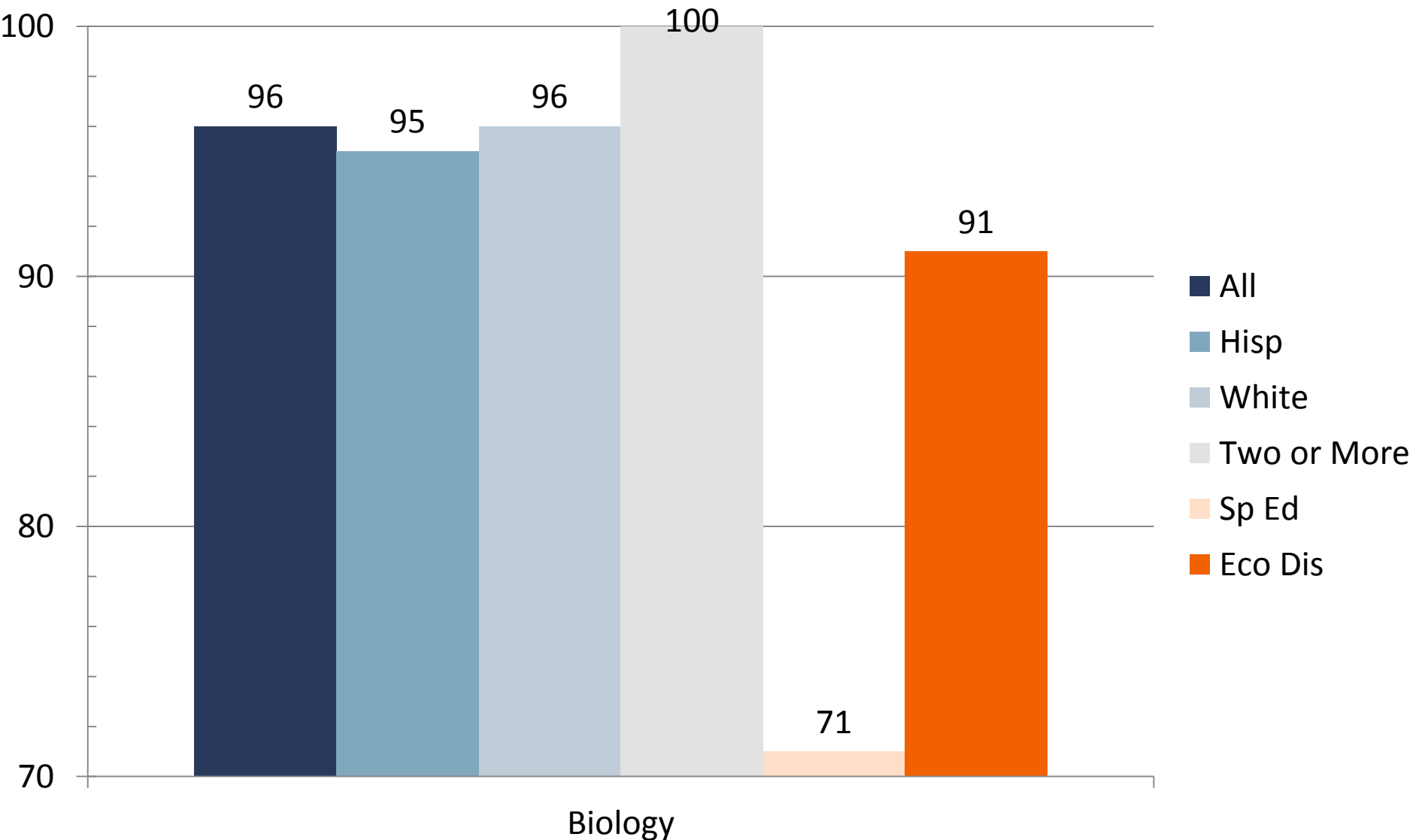
2016 STAAR 5 & 8 Science Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



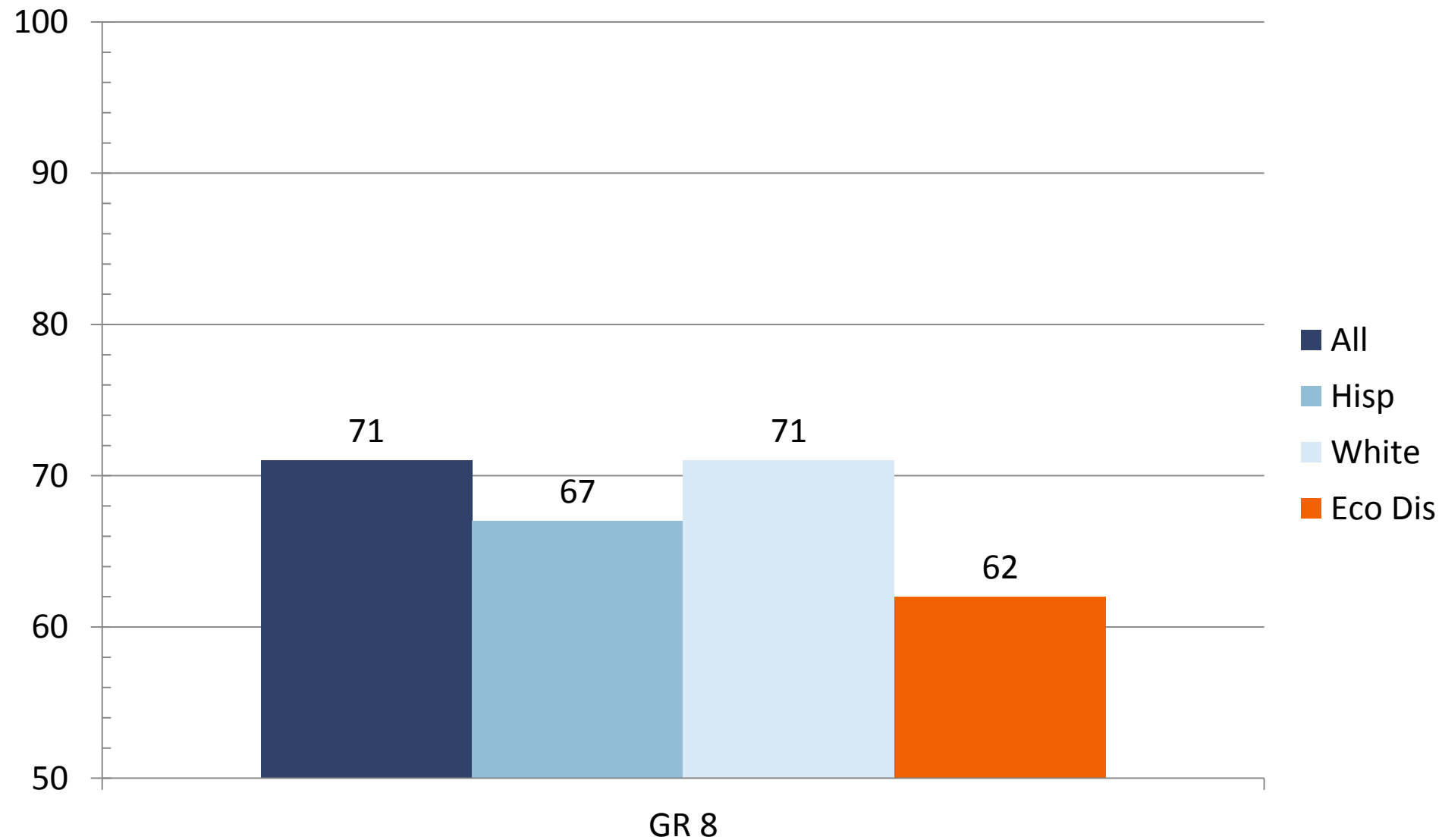
2016 STAAR End-of-Course: Biology

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



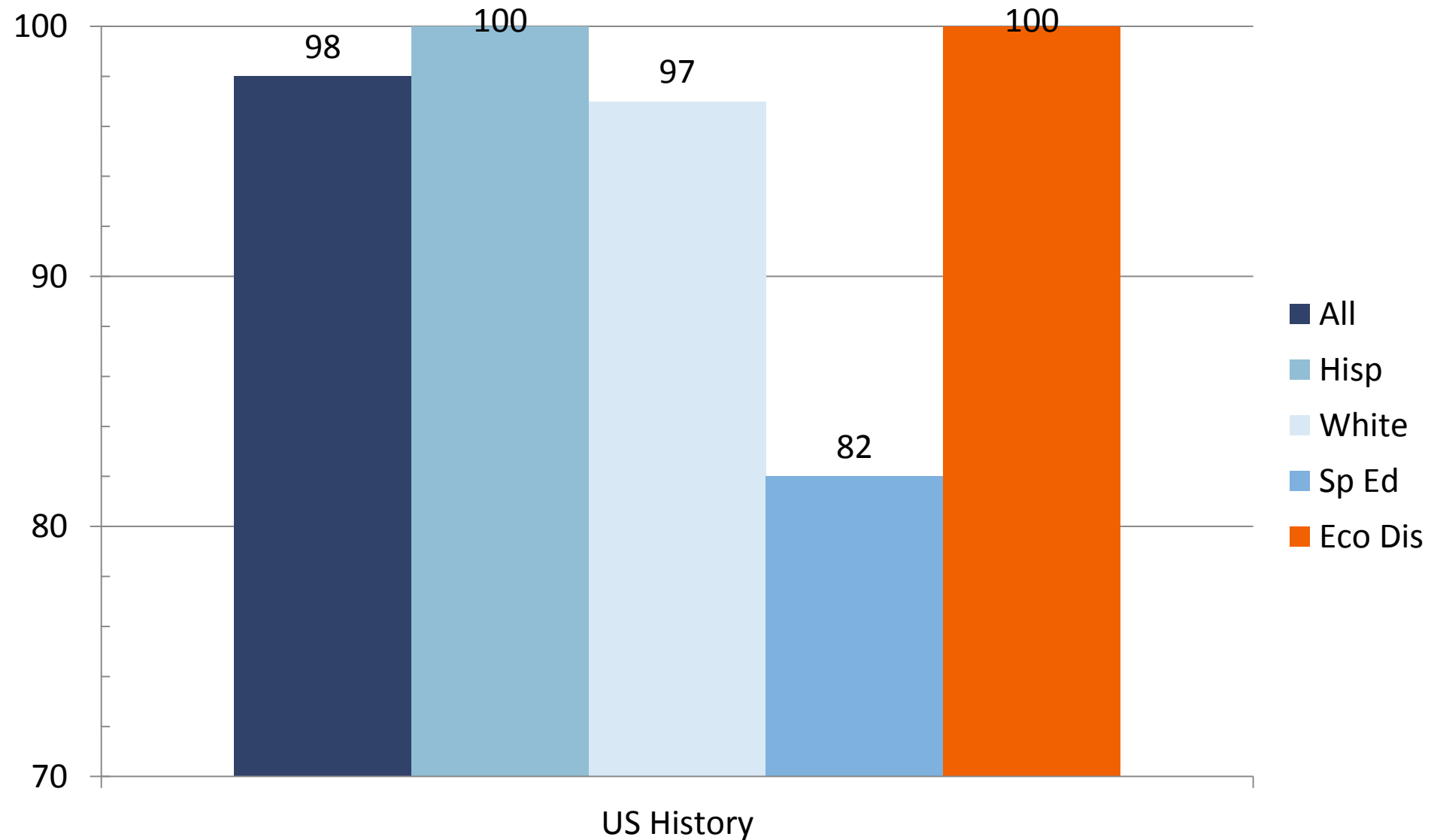
2016 STAAR 8 Social Studies Performance

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



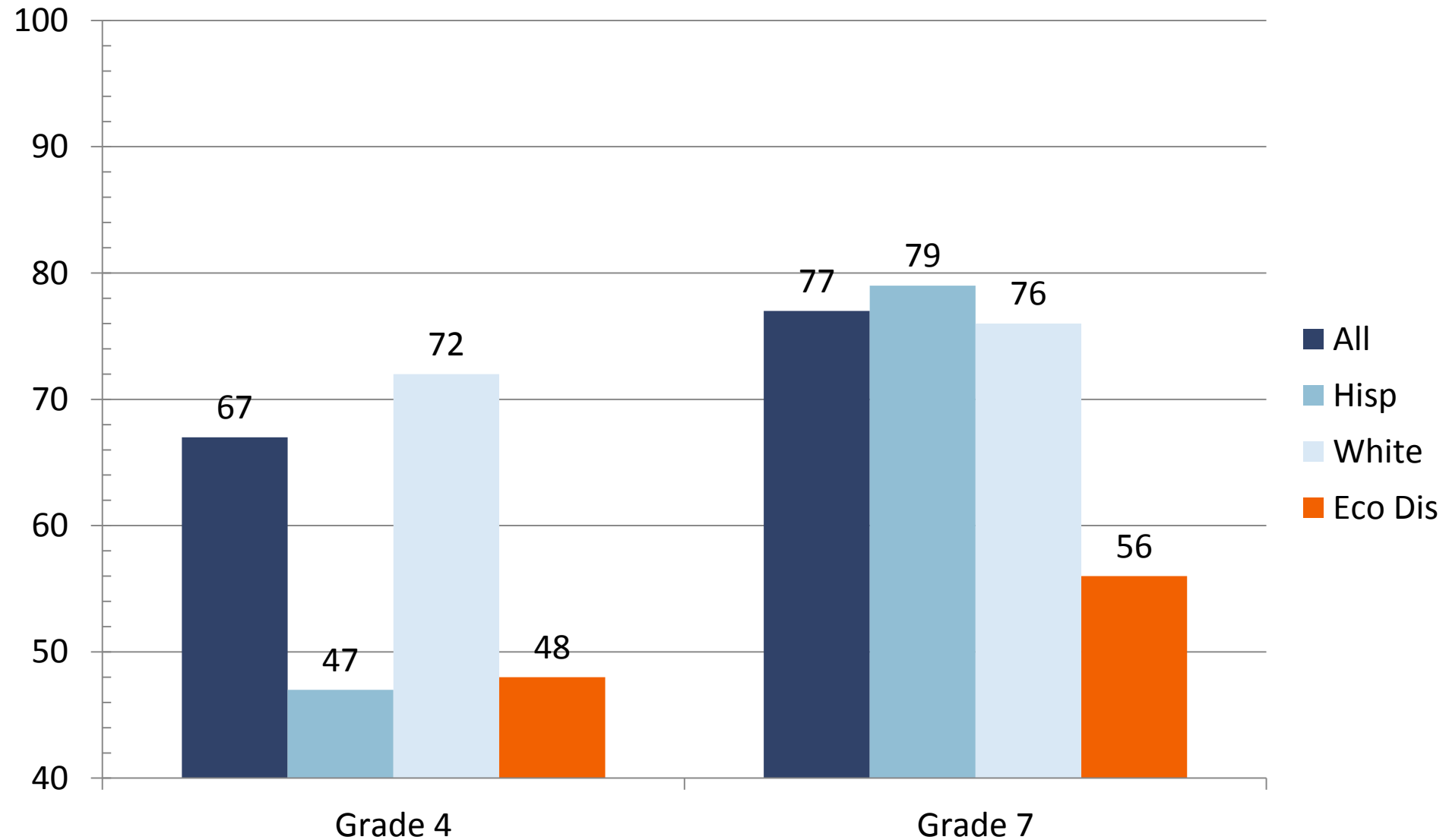
2016 STAAR End-of-Course: U.S. History

Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above

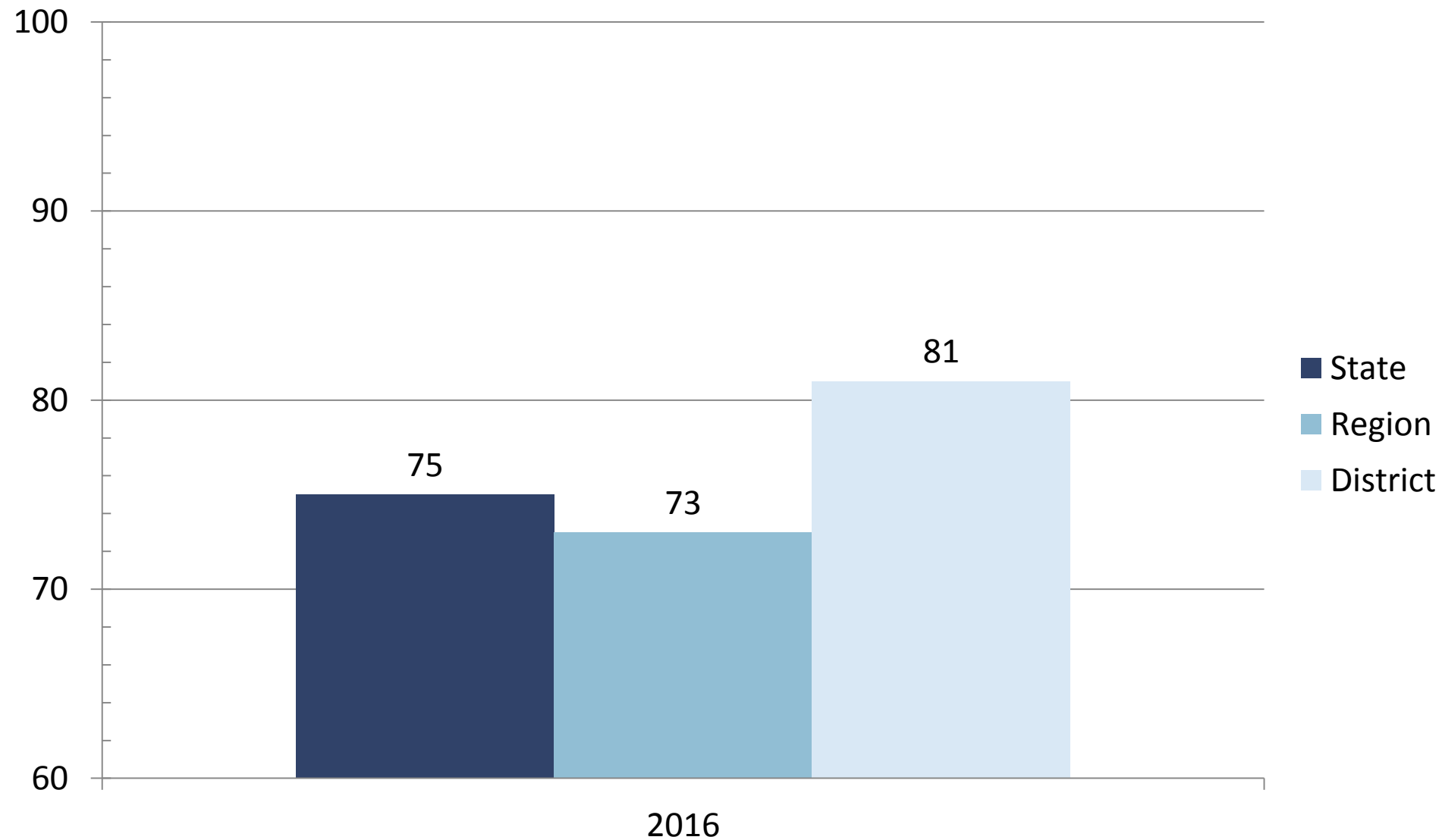


2016 STAAR 4 & 7 Writing Performance

Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above

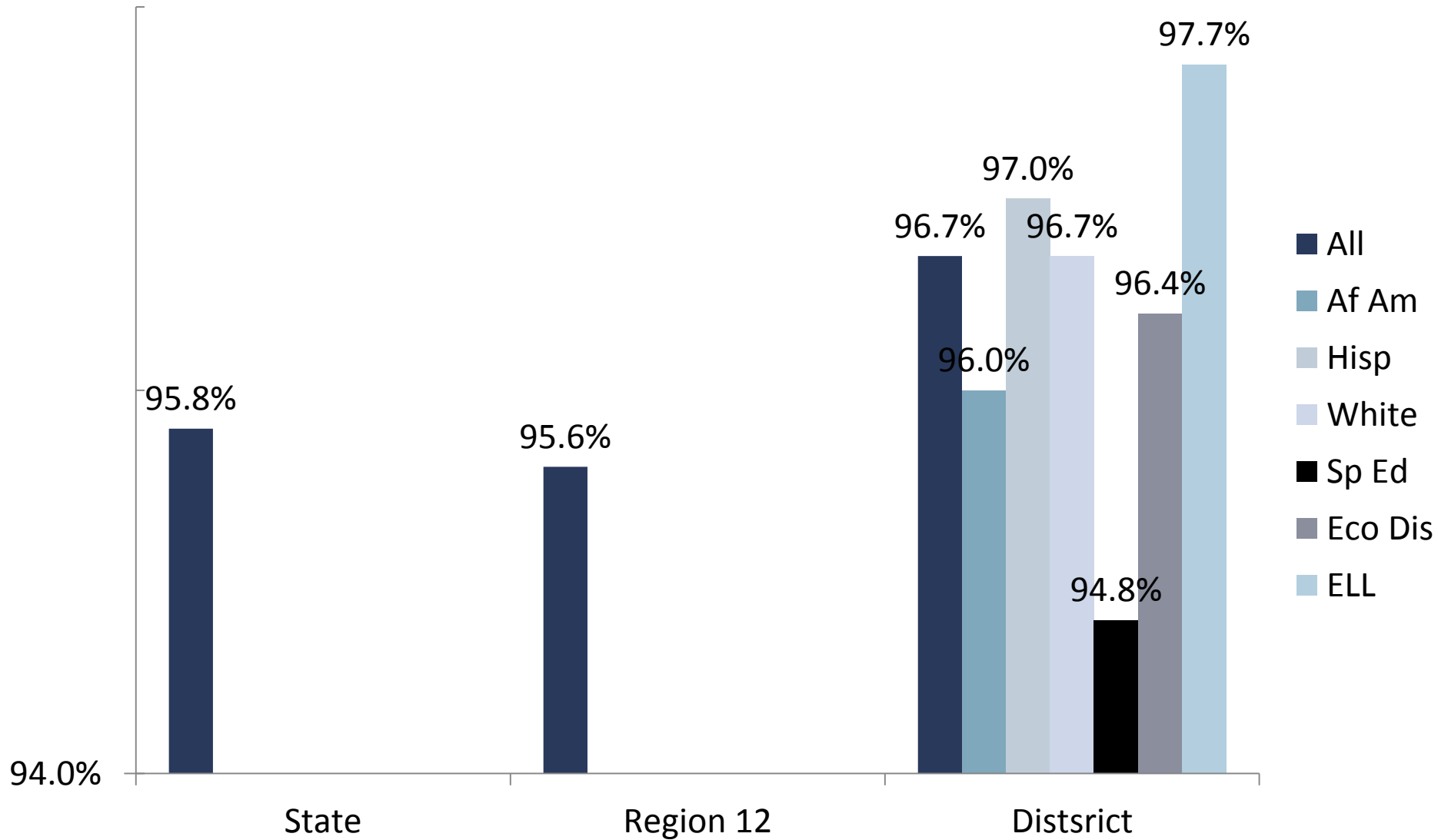


STAAR Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above All Grades, All Subjects



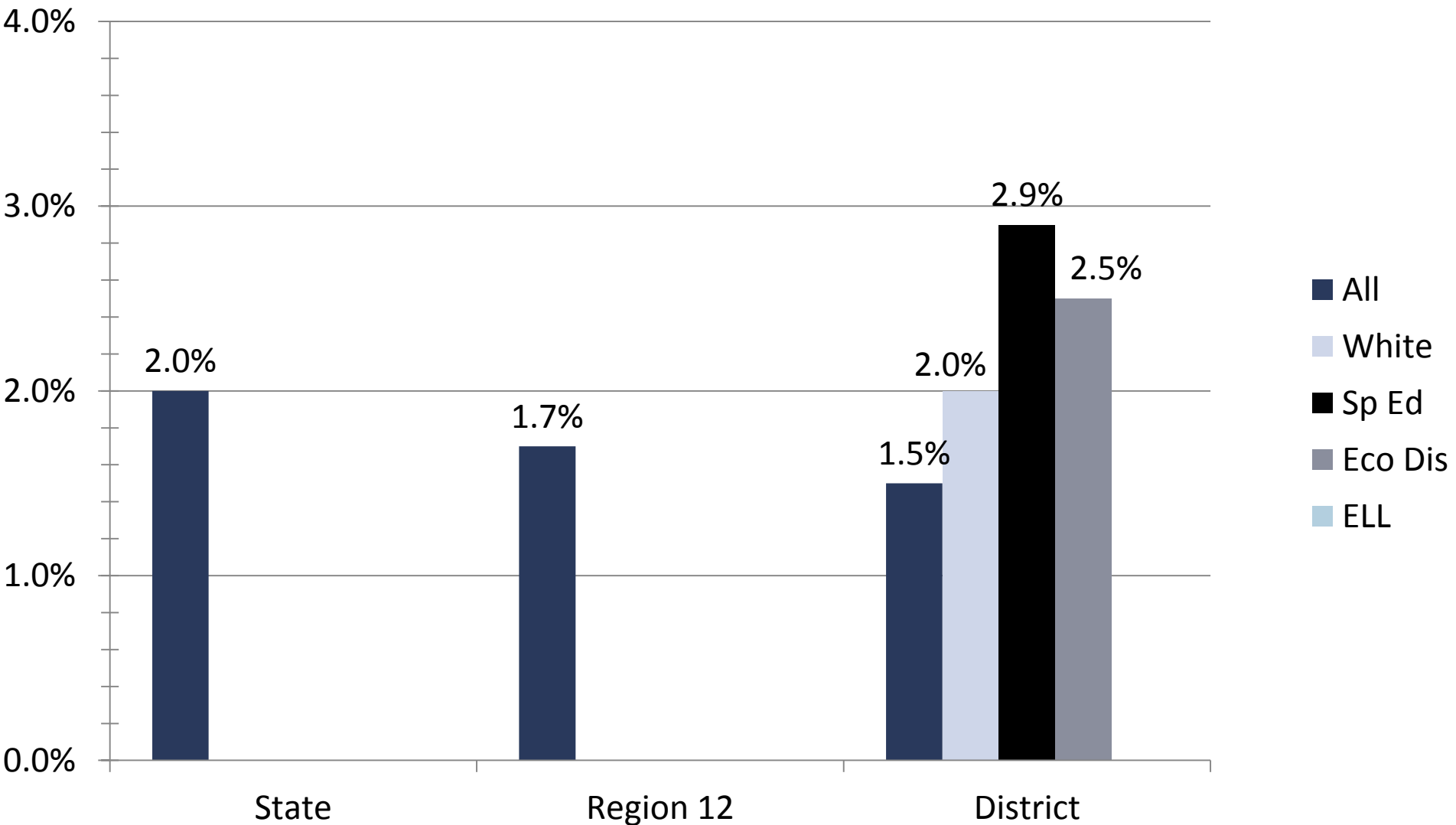
2017 Attendance

2015-2016 School Year



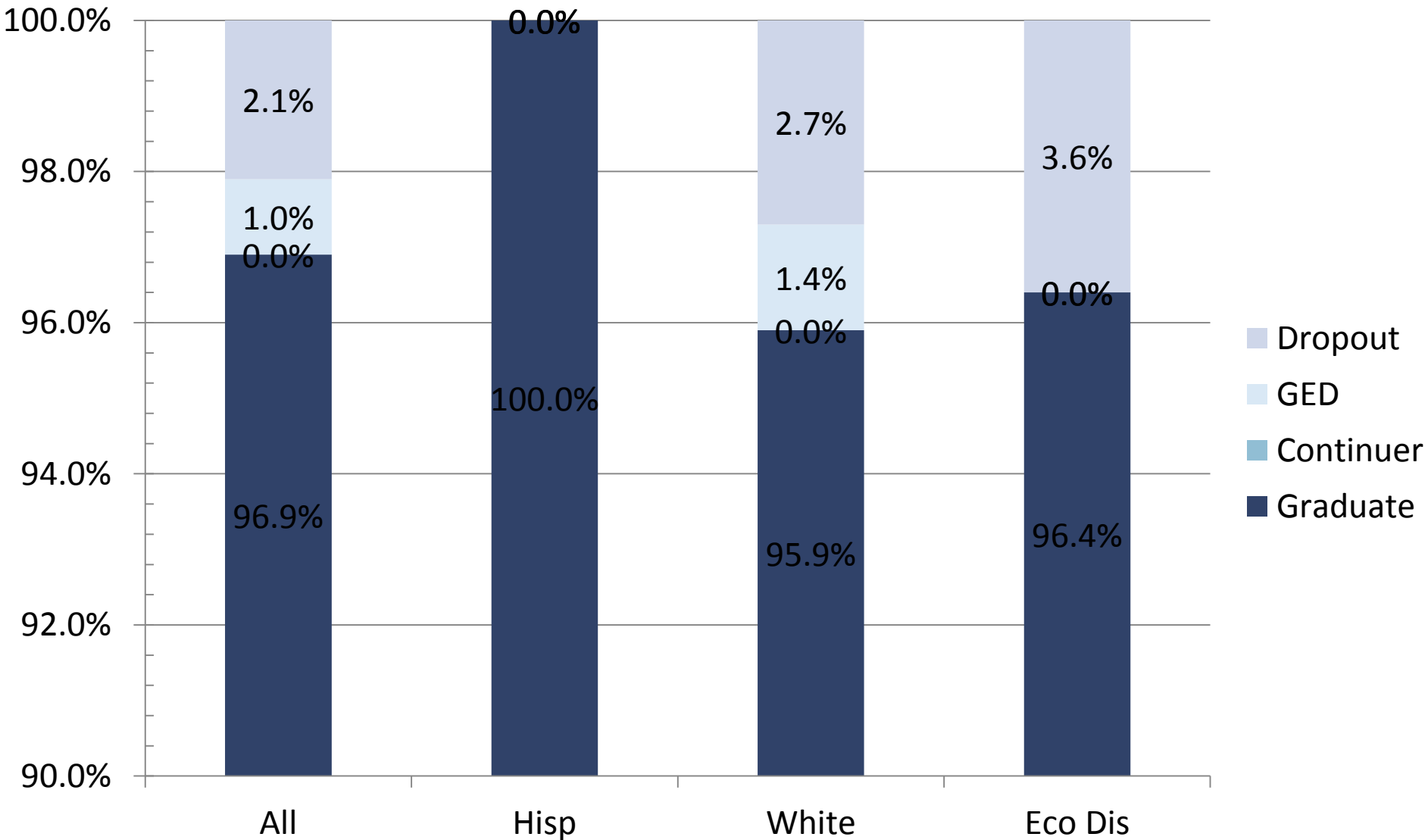
2017 Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 9-12)

2015-2016 School Year



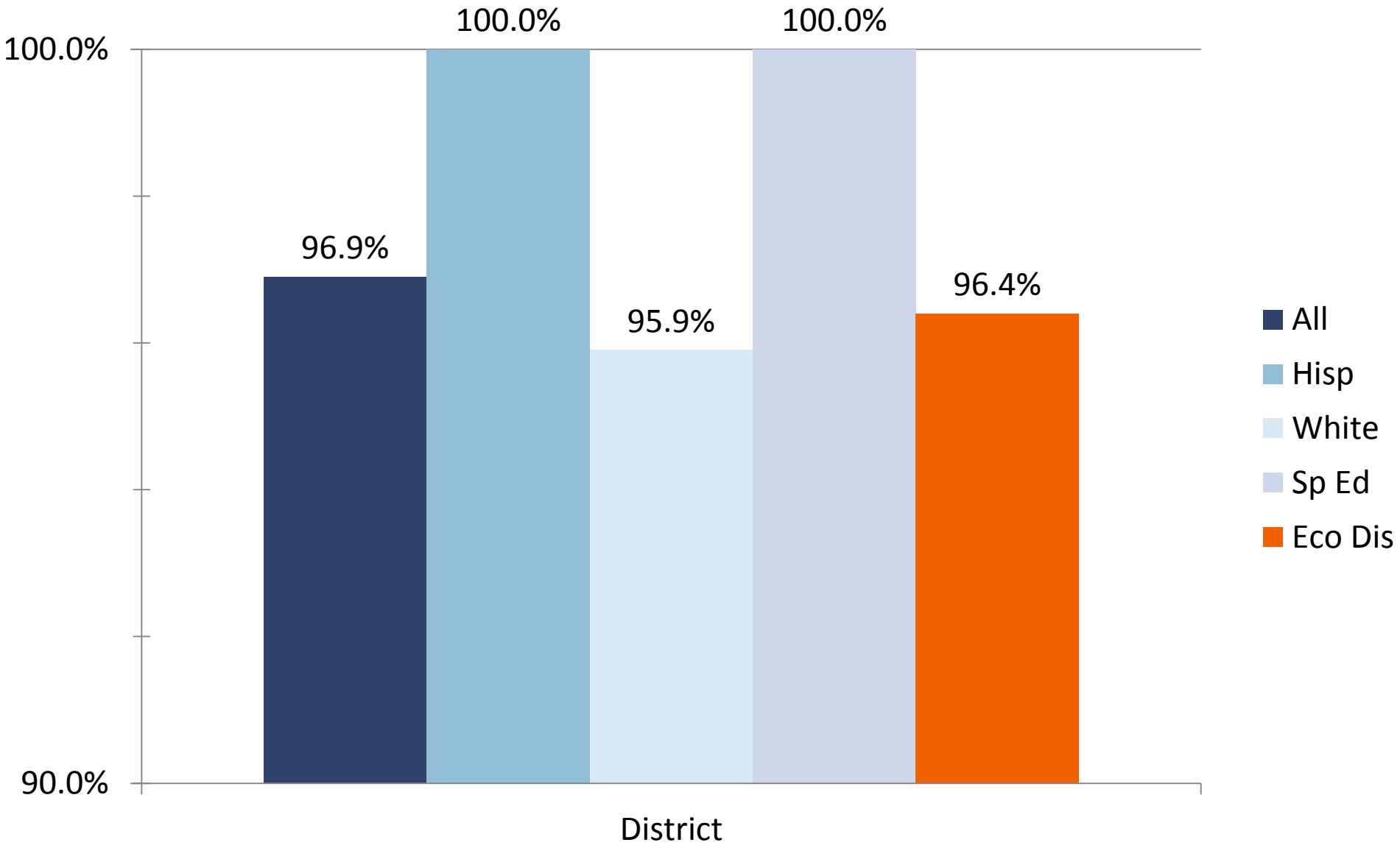
4-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate (Grades 9-12)

Class of 2016 Cohort

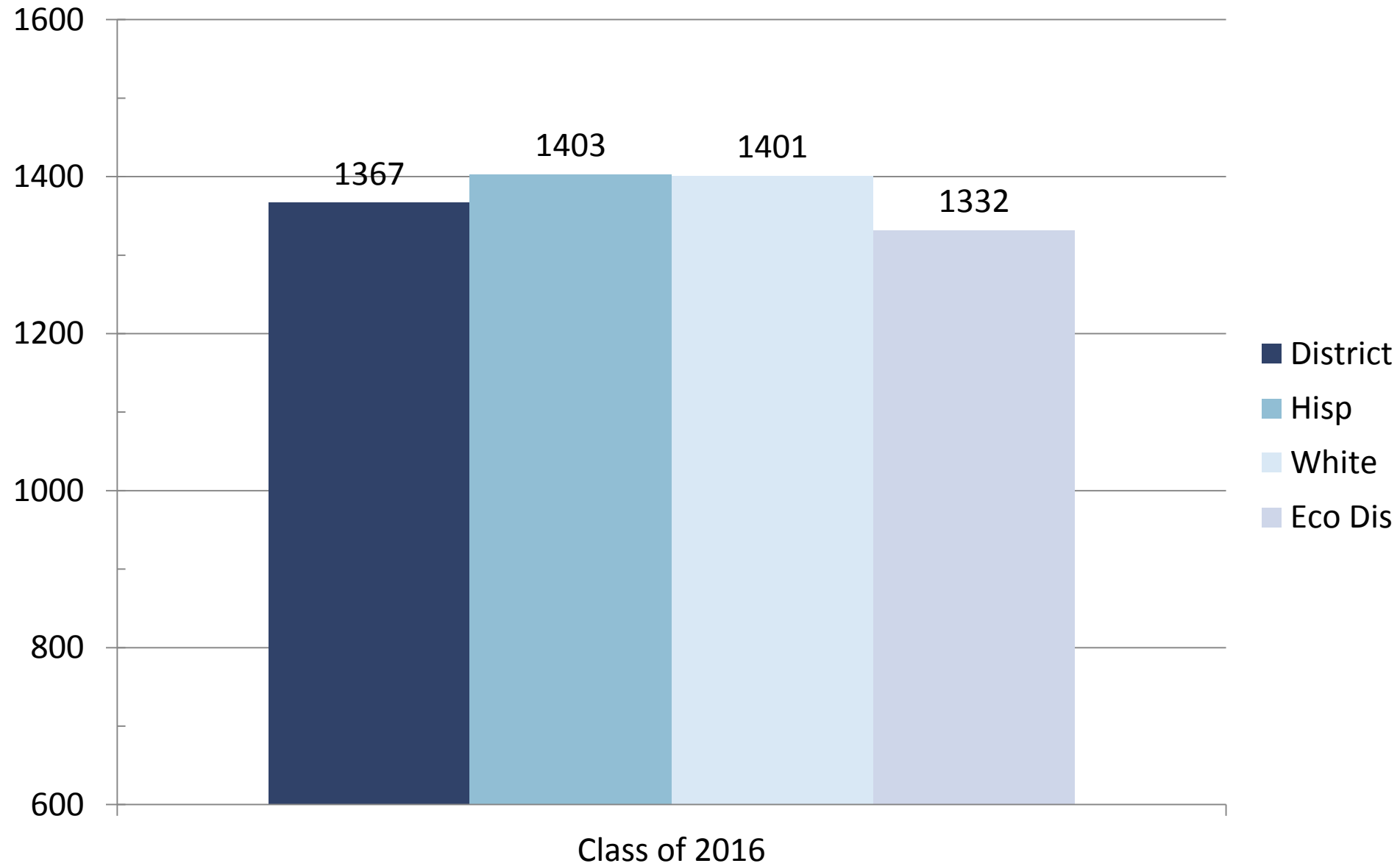


4-Year Federal Graduation Rate Without Exclusions (9-12)

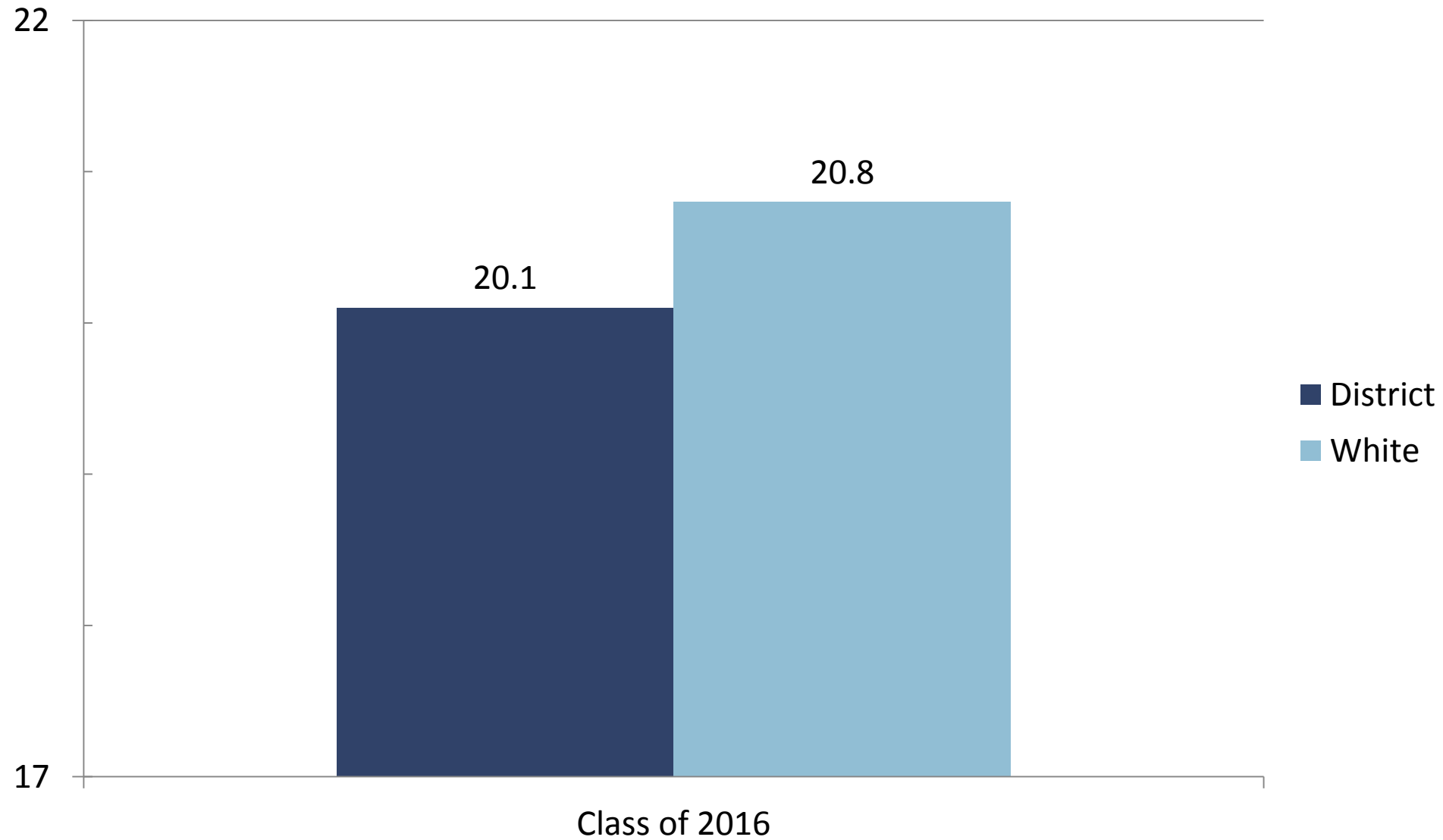

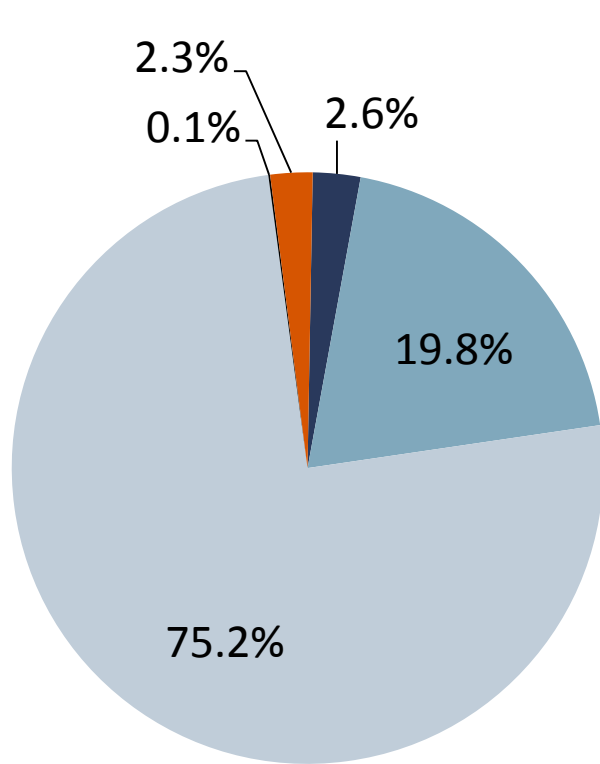
Average SAT Score, All Subjects



Average ACT Score, All Subjects

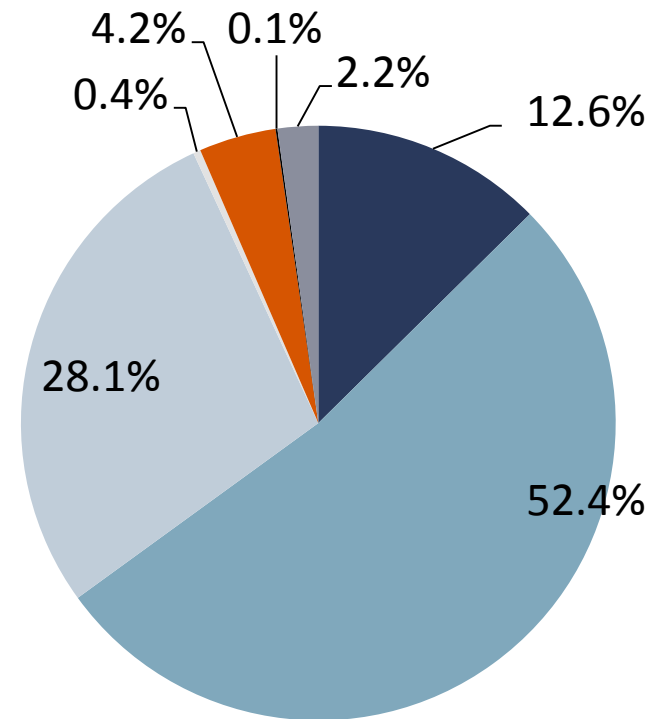


2017 Student Ethnic Distribution

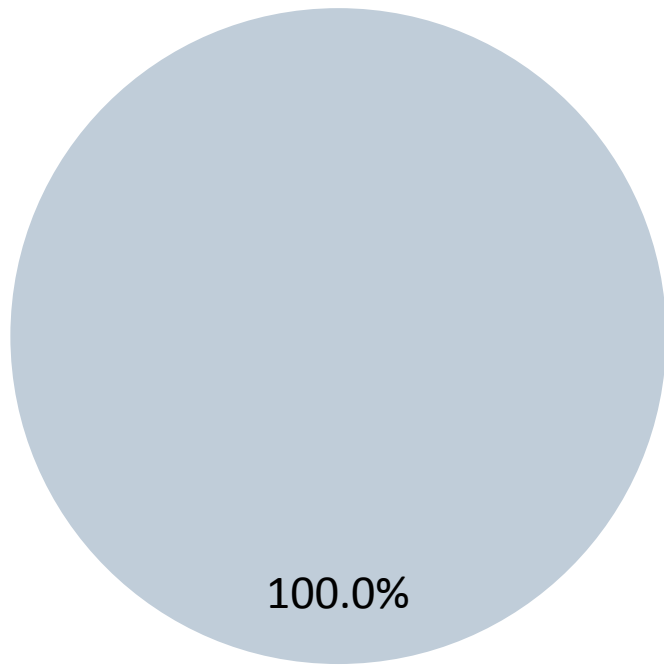

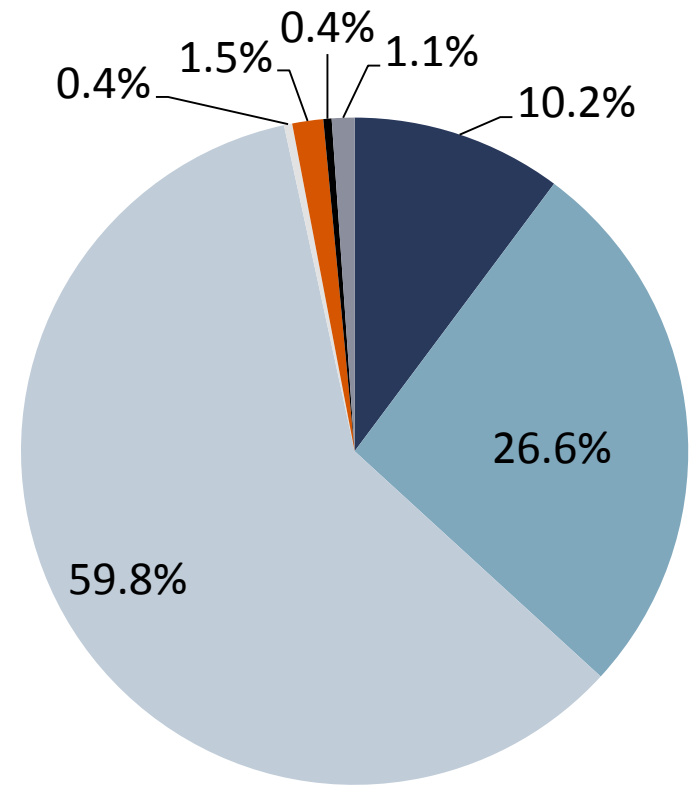

2017 Teacher Ethnic Distribution



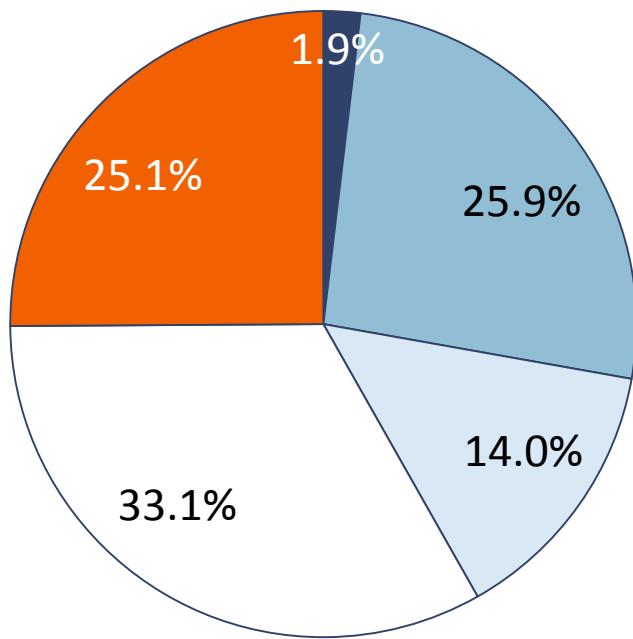

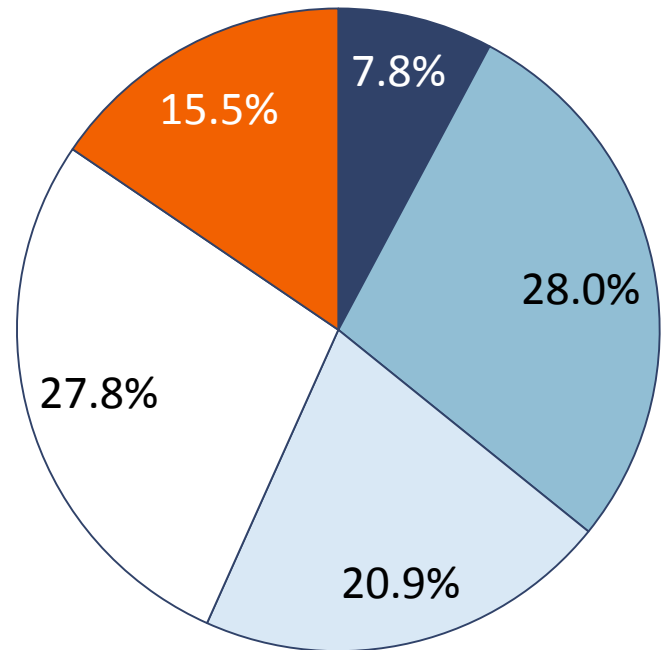

2017 Teacher's Years of Experience



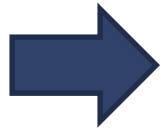

The accreditation status is based on the academic accountability rating and financial ratings from the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas. A district or charter must be accredited by the state to operate as a public school.

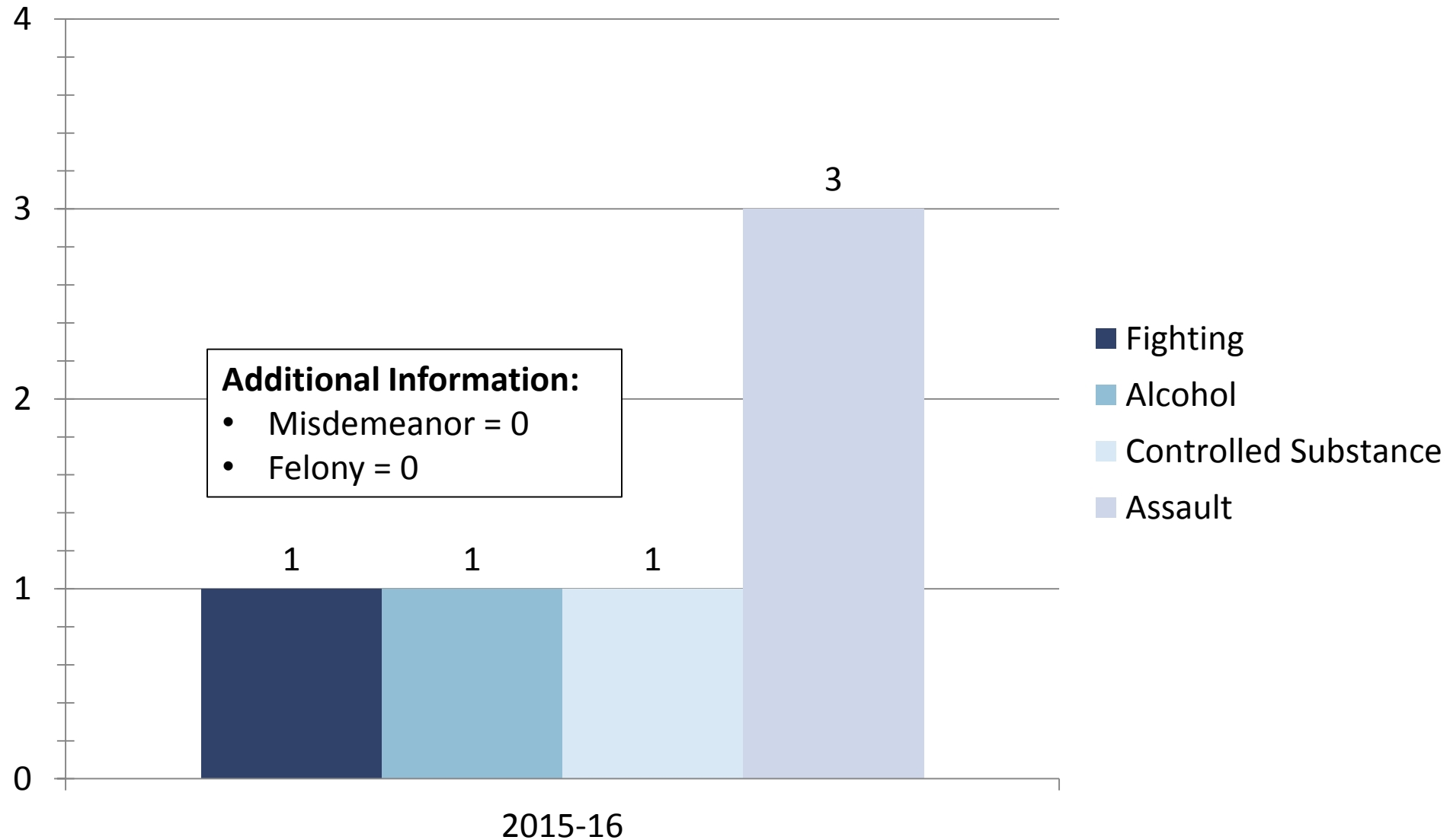

Violent and Criminal Incidents

- Texas statute (TEC 39.053) requires every district to publish an annual report on violent and criminal incidents at campuses in the district
- The report must include:
 - *Number, rate and type of incidents*
 - *Information concerning school violence prevention and intervention policies and procedures used by the district*
 - *Findings that result from Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act*

Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board

- Texas statute (TEC 51.403e) requires every district to include with its TAPR a report on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school. The report includes:
 - *Number of Total Graduates, disaggregated by attendance in Institutes of Higher Education*
 - *Number of Students within each GPA reporting band*

TAPR Highlights

- West ISD exceeded the State Passing Rate in all areas but Grade 3 Mathematics, Grade 3 Reading, and Grade 6 Math.
- West ISD exceeded the Region 12 Passing Rate in all areas but Grade 3 Mathematics and Grade 6 Mathematics.
- West ISD's Attendance Rate increased from 96.3% to 96.7%. Note: 2015-2016 data
- West ISD's Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 9-12) increased from .9% to 1.5%. Note: 2015-2016 data
- West ISD's Graduation Rate for the Class of 2015 was 96.9%.
