

## **Transition to Post Secondary**

As students complete their high school program and prepare to enter the adult world either by way of college, technical training, the military, or the workforce some students and parents may have concerns about the future. To help ease this developmental anxiety, Allen Park Public School students eligible for Special Education services participate in transition planning beginning at the age of 16.

A student's transition plan is completed through their Individual Education Program (IEP) and reviewed at least annually. The plan typically includes high school (secondary) and post-secondary (after high school) life goals and aspirations.

School staff will assist the student in completing surveys and/or interviews, goal-setting, and developing/implementing the transition plan to help the student as they begin to work toward meeting their life goals.
