

CARPOOL

Thank you for your patience with us as we run our new Carpool Procedure. We understand that it takes some getting used to, as it is very different from the past, but it is to ensure the safety of our students, your children.

Beginning today, no one may pick up their child from the school building. You must wait in the carpool line for your child. A teacher will walk the little ones directly to their car.

Should you forget your tag, we ask that you park, purchase a temporary day tag from the front office for \$1, and get back in the carpool line to pick up your child/children.

Catholic Charities does not begin their Aftercare Program until September, so we are dismissing over 250 students. Thanks again, for your patience and understanding.

REMINDERS

School Hours are from 7:45 AM to 3:30 PM each day. Your child will be marked tardy after 7:45 AM.

Morning care is before school from 7:15-7:45 AM. Please be sure you are dropping your child off in the cafeteria and not in the classroom.

After school care is from 4-6 PM every day in the school building. Catholic Charities Aftercare will begin in September. We will continue to hold after school care for those not on the Catholic Charities list for \$6 a day.

Please be sure your child is wearing the proper uniform. Please read the Parent/Student Handbook (on the homepage of the website) if you have any questions.

Please notify the office and your child's teacher if they will be going home with anyone not on the approved list filled out by you. Please give this person the Carpool Tag for the day.

Please subscribe to your child/children's teachers this year! Important information will go out through Teacher Pages.
