This Newsletter is an effort to keep you up to date on new developments in the District.

- **“WARNING”**- a recent malware attack on a local school may have begun with an email that “looked” familiar but had hidden malware causing significant effort and delay to correct. Don’t be the person who just clicks on and **Unknown email** without verifying that you know the sender or have requested the information....!
- The new Chromebooks and Carts for Grades 7 & 8 have been received and prepared for deployment during the Spring Break 2018. Each cart is stocked with sufficient units for each student’s use. Student’s will obtain their unit in the morning from their homeroom location and return the unit at the end of the day to be charged for the following days use. Chromebooks are not to leave the campus.
- Chromebooks and Carts have been deployed at the Achieve Program this month.
- New Safety communications additions include a mobile radio repeater at the Jr./Sr. High allowing stronger radio communications between the sports complex and the building.
- Building Management of non-educational devices (student phones and tablets) will help in maintaining the educational aspect of our online learning strategy in the future.
- We deployed chomebooks and carts for the Elementary buildings grades 3 – 6 during the Christmas 2017 Break. Staff PD was held in each building where each member received their unit and instruction. The schedule coordinates technology availability with the Teaching & Learning Strategic 5 year plan.
- **REMINDER:** The “Local C:” Folder is not to be used to save any material that would be lost if the system were to go down. This folder is NOT backed up and therefore if information is to be saved or used in the future it is to be saved in a network folder. Pictures and Videos not saved in a folder in Documents, on the Desktop or in Favorites are not backed up.

We are excited to be able to share this update with the District and to continue to help in the improvement of the educational environment for our students.

## **Addendum:**

Parking on Campus is in marked Lots and Locations only. Parking in unauthorized locations inhibits access by emergency vehicles and service vehicles. Parking in Fire lanes is a violation of the Fire Safety Code.

The speed limit on Campus is 15 MPH! Please keep our students safe!

Driving on campus is a privilege and can be revoked for violations.

**South Elementary's** address has changed to 1743 Adams Road.

Drivers **MUST** enter off Adams road as the driveway towards the Board of Education building is now **ONE WAY OUT**.

The parking lot between the Board building and South Elementary is a drop off point with walkers following the white pedestrian walkway to school.

The Werner Avenue entrance is permanently closed to school traffic and is designated for residents only!

## **5513-CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY**

The Board of Education believes that the schools should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.

The Board charges each student with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.

Students who cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures, and their parents shall be financially liable for such damage to the extent of the law, except that students over eighteen (18) years of age shall also be liable for damage they cause.

The Board authorizes the imposition of fines for the loss, damage or destruction of school equipment, apparatus, musical instruments, library material, textbooks, and for damage to school buildings and reserves the right, to the extent permitted by the law, to withhold a report card or credits from any student whose payment of such fine is in arrears.

The Board may report to the appropriate authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature.

A reward may be offered by the Board for the apprehension of any person who vandalizes school property.

The Superintendent shall develop administrative guidelines to implement this policy.
