



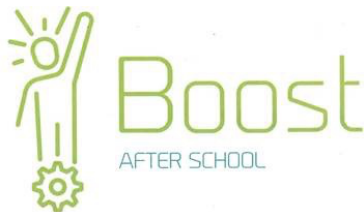
LMS Weekly Bulletin 12-14-18
