231-AR. SOCIAL EVENTS AND CLASS TRIPS

The senior class is not about destination, but rather about one last educational experience together as a class. To that end, a minimum of 50% of the senior class must agree to participate in the trip before approval will be granted.

Fees for participation in the trip should be an attainable amount for all students wishing to participate.

The senior class trip should be scheduled so those students will miss no more than one school day. Appropriate educational activities must be scheduled as part of the trip.

Advisors and chaperones will follow the guidelines outlined in Student Code of Conduct located in the *Student Handbook*.

A minimum of one adult chaperone for every ten students will be required.

Students will be monitored around the clock to ensure their safety and well being both during the day and at night. Curfew will be set and enforced by the chaperones. When staying in hotel rooms with in-room movies, the chaperone shall request non-rated as well as “X” and “R” rated movies to be turned off for all rooms housing students.
