

Titan Athletic Booster's Meeting February 17, 2016

1. Birgit Castlemen, President of the Titan Athletic Booster Club called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.
2. Birgit asked that our December Minutes be approved. Approval was given by Norm Doerges and Second by Angela Liang.
3. Dr. Bergmann handed out a spread sheet to Track, Football, Softball, Wrestling, Girls Water Polo, Girls Tennis and Boys Swim Team. The spread sheet contained the balance that was left in each of these accounts that were held at the district. If you were not given a spread sheet it was because your sport used the money or it was already transferred out to your team account.
 - a. This money can be used for consultants, banquet deposits and other necessities for your team. Please contact Desiree Verdugo for the proper paper work needed for submission.
 - b. Alcohol can not be apart of the funds your asking for reimbursement.
4. Mitch came in and we took a moment to pose for a picture for the tribune. I have attached the picture with the minutes.
5. Dr. Bergmann explained the SMHS Athletic budget that is given each year.
 - a. The Athletics department was given \$40,000 from the district because for the simple fact that Athletics donation section was left off of the First Day Packets. We then hope to get another \$40,000 in donations. This money is used for bare necessities for each sport. Such as, balls for all sports, bats, and what each individual coach feels his or her sport may need.
 - b. All funds given to the Athletics department has been used. So we have never had funds rolled over.
 - c. The district in the past have paid for referees for tournaments a program may have held. Financially this can no longer be something the district takes on. With this being said, each program this may effect should now work this cost into their budget.

- d. Uniforms: SMHS would like to have a four-year rotation on uniforms. This will allow each sport to have new uniforms. The varsity team will receive the new uniforms and the old uniforms would be passed down to your JV team and Frosh teams. If for some reason in two years' new uniforms are needed or replacements, then your booster club can decide to purchase them for you.
 - e. Banquets: Please make sure that DR, Nick or Eve are aware of your banquet date and location. This is to ensure that nothing is going on with other departments that would interfere with a student not being able to attend. Julie Boucher, Asst. Superintendent, Business Services stated that the district can also help teams that may not have a lot of funds to go to a restaurant or banquets hall. She said that the school cafeteria or career center is available to all groups/teams at SMHS. They would not charge to use the facility, however, they would mark up the food by 10% to 15%. As stated before, boosters can cover the full cost of your team banquet. They are also aware that some teams can not have one banquet for their whole team (such as football, baseball and so on). However, if possible they would ask that if you can please have one team banquet. This will ensure that at least one school administrator can attend.
 - f. Full Time Trainer: Dr. Bergmann trying to see if a full time trainer can be a part of our school budget. However, as of now we are contracted with Catz in Pasadena. The going rate for a trainer is \$25 an hour. The boosters can pay for the total cost of a trainer, however, the school does not cover this cost. This cost can also come from your ASB account.
