## ***APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS***

This application is for 1998 or later graduates of Baker County High Schools or individuals who are recipients of a General Equivalency Diploma of a duly credited institution in Oregon who, at the time of receiving their diploma, are residents of the Baker County School District.

The scholarship is awarded for a period of one year and is renewable for a total of four years during the six-year period following high school graduation. In order to qualify for renewal, scholarship recipients are required to maintain enrollment in a full time program and a 3.0 or better GPA.

2. Two one-page letters of recommendation (*new applicants only*):
  - a) One from an educator;
  - b) One from a person outside the school system.
3. A one-page personal statement about yourself, your goals and why you should receive this scholarship.
4. A copy of pages one and two of most recently filed Federal Tax Return of **BOTH** parents and applicant, including non-custodial parents.

**Applications will be considered only if all necessary forms and documents are postmarked by April 15.**

# STEWART SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP

## *Guidelines*

- ◆ The STEWART SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP is awarded annually during the month of May.
- ◆ Scholarship recipients must attend a college, university or trade school located in the State of Oregon.
- ◆ Scholarship funds are payable to the school and are disbursed equally by term or semester.
- ◆ Any unused portion of an award is returned to the scholarship fund.
- ◆ The application deadline is April 15th. Late applications are not accepted.

## *Background*

*Stewart Sullivan's early years were spent attending school and working on the family ranch in Hereford. He was proud of his Irish heritage and knew the meaning of hard work and frugality.*

*Following several years of service in the U.S. Navy, Sullivan resided in Baker City for the remainder of his life. He was employed as an agriculture field man for U.S. Bank until his retirement in 1979.*

*He loved to fish and hunt and was a great story teller. Sullivan's extensive knowledge of Baker County history enabled him to narrate the story of the gold display in the U.S. Bank Baker City Branch.*

*Sullivan was a loyal fan of Baker High School sporting events and a great supporter of the Baker County young people. Upon his death in 1998, Mr. Sullivan's Last Will and Testament established the Stewart Sullivan Scholarship Trust in memory of his sister, Mabel Sullivan Erickson.*



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
