### **Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program**

The application window is now open for the 2017-2018 Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program. This is separate from St. Anthony School's Tuition Assistance; those applications will be available in the spring.

For the Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program:

- Applications are completed and submitted *completely online*.
- Nothing will be printed or signed and turned into the school.

Along with the application, each family is asked to pay a \$24 fee to FACTS to apply for Fulcrum tuition assistance. The \$24 fee covers all applications for 1 year, and will be fully reimbursed so long as their student(s), regardless of whether they are awarded a Fulcrum grant or not, enrolls in a Catholic school for the 2017-2018 school year. If you have more than one child attending a Catholic school, only one application and one fee is required.

The deadline for submitting your application online is January 6, 2017. No Fulcrum Applications will be accepted or considered for funding after the deadline. The application is available in both English and Spanish. The link to the application is below:

FACSA would like to thank every parent and student volunteer for all your help with Octoberfest 2016. We are truly grateful to


