

Soleado Elementary Expected Student Behaviors

Students at Soleado will...

1. **Walk** as they move through the hallways and around the campus. **No running on the blacktop, except as part of a game. Running is permitted on the grass field.**
2. **Eat at the tables only.** Upper grade students may sit on the ground to eat. Snacks may be eaten at the tables or at the benches by the blacktop.
3. **Eat only at the designated tables** and not on the playground. Buying, selling and trading of food is not allowed.
4. **Raise his/her hand to be dismissed** from lunch tables.
5. **Throw away trash** before lining up for the playground.
6. **Play only games that are safe** and free from rough-housing and physical contact.
7. **Play only approved playground games. Play according to posted game rules.** Taking turns on all playground equipment is mandatory. (20 count)
8. Play with school issued equipment only. Toys or sports equipment from home is not permitted at school.
9. **Play in designated play areas only.**
10. **Use the bathrooms quickly, always cleaning up after themselves.** They may not play in or around the bathrooms.
11. **Freeze, stand up, and stop talking when the bell rings.** Walk to class lines when the whistle blows.
12. Return all balls to the cart or classroom.
13. **Treat all classmates and members of the school community with respect and kindness in their words and actions.**

The students of Soleado will also:

1. **Be on time** to school and to class. (Playground opens at 8:15 am.) Students arriving before 8:15 must wait on the ramps.
2. **Be polite and respectful** to all adults on campus. Address all adults by their proper title: Mrs. Miss, Ms. Mr.
3. **Enter a classroom only when an adult is present.**
4. **Use respectful language at all times.** Profanity and swear words of any kind are not allowed.
5. **Dress appropriately for school.** Sandals and open toed shoes are not allowed, revealing clothes, including mid-drifts, are not appropriate for school.
6. **Wear hats and caps when outdoors only** with the bill of the hat facing forward.
7. Follow classroom standards set by the teacher. Be respectful of all school property and the personal property of others.
