Underage Users' Group

ARIN Intermediate Unit 28 provides an education and intervention program to help youth, ages 12-21, deal with Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs (ATOD) issues.

The goals for the Underage Users' Group are to:

- ◆ increase awareness of the effects of alcohol and other drugs on an individual basis;
- ◆ provide insight into why people abuse substances;
- ◆ study consequences of substance abuse;
- ◆ examine alternatives to substance use; and,
- ◆ provide referral services for ATOD problematic behavior patterns.

Responsibilities of Participants

Participation in the Underage Users' Group is **VOLUNTARY**. Youth choosing to participate agree to the following conditions and responsibilities of compliance:

- ◆ attend two, three-hour group sessions (Participants must arrive on time and remain for the entire session.);
- ◆ participate by sharing information and working toward program goals;
- ◆ maintain confidentiality (Revealing to another person the names of group participants or any information they discuss may result in discharge from the group.);
- ◆ practice healthy, constructive life direction. Participation in the program, while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs will result in discharge from the program; and,
- ◆ Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition (ARD) clients must comply with all assessment recommendations.

Failure to comply with the above group requirements will result in a non-compliance notification to the referral source.

(Documentation of attendance is sent to the referral source, such as the magisterial district judge/probation.)

◆ Who?

Adolescents identified by law enforcement officers, probation offices, schools, or agencies as substance abusers and who have been charged with underage drinking or other related offenses.

◆ What?

Program focuses on basic information regarding alcohol and other drugs, which is geared toward youth.

◆ When?

Group classes are scheduled monthly. Classes are composed of two, three-hour sessions. **Participants will register for classes via the iu28.org website. See instructions on back of brochure.**

◆ Where?

ARIN IU 28 Central Office, 2895 W. Pike, Indiana, PA, approximately three miles west of Indiana, Pennsylvania

◆ Cost?

The fee for the six hours is \$80.00, payable by credit card or Paypal using the link provided through the ARIN website, www.iu28.org, or by check, cash, or money order at the first class. Checks and money orders will be made payable to ARIN IU 28.
