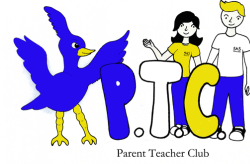

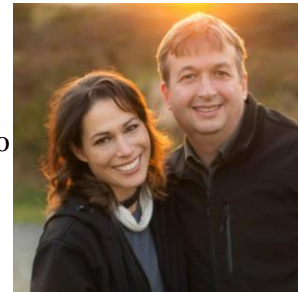


### Mark Your Calendar: The 2nd PTC General Meeting is on Thursday, January 18th beginning at 6 pm
