Vallivue School District 139

The five (5) trustee zones for Vallivue School District 139, Canyon County, will be as follows:

Trustee Zone No. 1

Beginning at the intersection of Homedale Road and Farmway Road;

- Thence southerly along Farmway Road to Karcher Road;
- Thence easterly along Karcher Road to 10th Avenue;
- Thence southerly along 10th Avenue and the district boundary across Lake Lowell
- Thence southerly and westerly along the district boundary to the Snake River;
- Thence northwesterly along the Snake River and the district boundary;
- Thence departing the Snake River and easterly and northerly along the district boundary;
- Thence westerly along the district boundary to the Snake River;
- Thence northwesterly along the Snake River and the west district boundary;
- Thence departing the Snake River and northerly and easterly along the district boundary to the Boise River:
- Thence southeasterly along the Boise River and the district boundary to Wagner Road;
- Thence southerly along Wagner Road to Ustick Road;
- Thence westerly along Ustick Road to Malt Road:
- Thence southerly along the southerly extension of Malt Road and the district boundary to Homedale Road:
- Thence easterly along Homedale Road to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Trustee Zone No. 2

Beginning at the intersection with Homedale Road and Farmway Road;

- Thence easterly along Homedale Road to Montana Avenue:
- Thence northerly along Montana Avenue;
- Thence easterly, northerly and westerly along the district boundary to Montana Avenue;
- Thence northerly along Montana Avenue to Ustick Road;
- Thence easterly along Ustick Road to Lake Avenue;
- Thence southerly along Lake Avenue to Karcher Road;
- Thence easterly along Karcher Road to Midway Road;
- Thence southerly along Midway Road to Flamingo Avenue;
- Thence easterly along Flamingo Avenue to Midland Road;
- Thence southerly along Midland Road to Orchard Avenue:
- Thence westerly along Orchard Avenue to 10th Avenue;
- Thence northerly along 10th Avenue to Karcher Road:
- Thence westerly along Karcher Road to Farmway Road;
- Thence northerly along Farmway Road to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Trustee Zone No. 3

Beginning at the intersection of Ustick Road and Lake Avenue;

- Thence easterly along Ustick Road and Lake Avenue;
- Thence easterly along Cleveland Blvd. and Caldwell Blvd. to Karcher Road and the northerly extension of the easterly most portion of Cassia Street;
- Thence southerly along Cassia Street and the northerly extension of easterly most portion thereof to Flamingo Avenue;
- Thence westerly along Flamingo Avenue to Midway Road;
- Thence northerly along Midway Road to Karcher Road;
- Thence westerly along Karcher Road to Lake Avenue;
- Thence northerly along Lake Avenue to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Trustee Zone No. 4

Beginning at the intersection of Middleton Road and US Highway 20/26;

- Thence northerly along Middleton Road to the Boise River;
- Thence easterly along the Boise River and the district boundary to Can-Ada Road;
- Thence southerly along Can-Ada Road to Ustick Road;
- Thence easterly along Ustick Road to Star Road;
- Thence southerly along Star Road to Franklin Road;
- Thence westerly along the district boundary to Franklin Blvd.;
- Thence northerly along Franklin Blvd. to Ustick Road;
- Thence westerly along Ustick Road to Northside Blvd.;
- Thence northerly along Northside Blvd. to Linden Road;
- Thence westerly along Linden Road to Midland Road;
- Thence northerly along Midland Road to US Highway 20/26;
- Thence westerly on US Highway 20/26 to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Trustee Zone No. 5

Beginning at the intersection of Cleveland Boulevard and Ustick Road;

- Thence easterly along Ustick Road to the westerly district boundary;
- Thence northerly and westerly along the district boundary to the Boise River;
- Thence easterly along the Boise River and the district boundary to Middleton Road;
- Thence southerly along Middleton Road to US Highway 20/26;
- Thence easterly along US Highway 20/26 to Midland Road;
- Thence southerly along Midland Road to Linden Road;
- Thence easterly along Linden Road to Northside Blvd.;
- Thence southerly on Northside Blvd. to Karcher Road;
- Thence westerly along Karcher Road to Midland Road;
- Thence southerly along Midland Road to Flamingo Avenue;
- Thence westerly along Flamingo Avenue to Cassia Street;
- Thence northerly along eastern most portion of Cassia Street to the northerly extension thereof to Karcher Road and Caldwell Blvd.;
- Thence northwesterly along Caldwell Blvd. and Cleveland Blvd. to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

*Above descriptions approved by the Idaho State Department of Education on September 21, 2001, as part of population equalization project (HB 191). Use of road names and landmarks to outline each zone replaces technical legal language previously used.

REDEFINING TRUSTEE ZONES

The boundaries of the trustee zones in this district are to be defined and drawn so that, as reasonably as may be, each such zone shall have approximately the same population. Trustee zones in this district will be determined to have approximately the same population when the populations of each trustee zone do not vary by more than ten percent (10%).

The board of trustees will initiate a proposal to redefine and change trustee zones at the first meeting following the report of the decennial census. In addition, the board or a patron may propose that a trustee zone be redefined at any time. Within one hundred twenty (120) days following the report of the decennial census or the receipt of a petition to redefine and change the trustee zones, the board will prepare a proposal for a change which will equalize the population in each trustee zone. The proposal will include a legal description of each trustee zone as the same would appear pursuant to the proposal, a map of the district showing how each trustee zone would appear, and the approximate population each trustee zone would have, should the proposal become effective.

The proposal will be submitted to the State Board of Education for approval. The State Board of Education will approve or disapprove of the proposal within sixty (60) days and give notice of its decision to the board in writing. If approved, the trustee zones will change pursuant to the proposal. If disapproved, the board must submit a revised proposal to the State Board of Education within forty-five (45) days.

IMPLEMENTATION OF PROPOSAL TO REDEFINE TRUSTEE ZONES

At the next regular meeting of the board following the approval of the proposal, the board will appoint from its membership a trustee for each new trustee zone to serve as trustee until that incumbent trustee's three (3) year term expires. If the current board membership includes two (2) incumbent trustees from the same new trustee zone, the board will select the incumbent trustee with the most seniority as the trustee to serve the remainder of his or her three (3) year term. If both incumbent trustees have equal seniority, the board will choose one (1) of the trustees by the drawing of lots. If there is a trustee vacancy in any trustee zone, the board will appoint an individual residing in the trustee zone to serve as trustee until the next annual meeting.
