Kathleen and Kevin Driscoll will be awarded the Jack and Eileen Connors Award at a May 16 reception at the Boston College Club. They will be honored for their extraordinary service to Saint John Paul II Catholic Academy, the largest Catholic elementary school in the Northeast. As founders of the school in 2008, the Driscolls lead the Campaign for Catholic Schools and assisted with transforming seven Catholic elementary schools into one consolidated school on four campuses in Dorchester/Mattapan. Kathleen was a founding trustee of Saint John Paul II Catholic Academy and Kevin served on the Campaign for Lower Mills, the \$10.2 million “mini-campaign” of CCS, which allowed for the full renovation of the Lower Mills campus of the Academy, the sixth school renovation of the CCS since 2007. From leading school implementation meetings, introducing new friends to Catholic education, and moving school furniture and books into the school, the Driscolls have done it all.

Kathleen and Kevin are both products of Catholic education from elementary grades through college. While Kathleen attended Catholic schools in New York before graduating from Boston College, Kevin proudly attended Holy Name, St. Sebastian (where he has served on the Board for many years) and then Fairfield University.

Kathleen is the Secretary for Institutional Advancement at the Archdiocese of Boston and Kevin is a Vice President, Financial Advisor, Wealth Brokerage Services at Wells Fargo. The Driscolls currently reside in Cohasset. Their six children also attended Catholic schools and have joined them in volunteering and teaching at Saint John Paul II Catholic Academy. The Driscolls’ oldest son, Ryan, serves on the Academy board, and their oldest daughter, Katherine, worked at the Academy for five years.
