Happy Tuesday, Wildcat Families!

Please take a minute to read just a few reminders about our morning Valet/student drop off:

- The Alta Vista campus opens at 7:30am with student supervision. Students may NOT be dropped off before that time or will be escorted to the office and a parent contacted.
- The AV Valet line is a single lane. Once your child has safely exited your vehicle, cars may NOT pass the line on the left. The left side is for staff vehicles pulling in to park.
- Cars exiting from the AV Valet area MUST take a left-hand turn only. There are several signs posted and failure to follow the traffic signs results in a pricey ticket and puts oncoming cars and students in jeopardy.
- The parking lot on Julia street is for STAFF parking only. This is not a secondary location for dropping your child off as it puts them in great danger.
- As a final reminder, please be mindful that student safety is our top priority. By providing 45 minute window in the morning for drop-offs

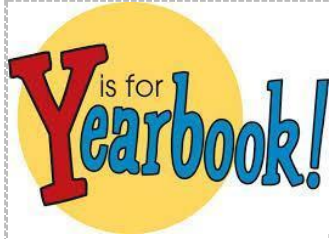
