SUBJECT: PETITIONS

When budgets are defeated and the Board of Education declares contingency, non-contingent budget items are eliminated. Community residents seeking the reinstatement of non-contingent items may, however, with the proper number of signatures, present petitions to the Board of Education requesting that items be resubmitted for voter approval.

The decision as to whether the item is to be resubmitted to voters, however, rests with the Board of Education.

In an effort to be consistent and fair, the Board of Education (within any budget year) shall submit (as a result of petitions) only twice the same non-contingent item (such as equipment, athletics) for voter approval.
