NCAA Eligibility initiative keeps athletes on the right track

When college recruiters come to town to scout out potential talent, the first thing they want to know is if the athlete is on track to be an NCAA Qualifier.

While there are state and local requirements for graduation, the NCAA has its own set of standards that go beyond the average high school requisites. If a student athlete doesn't meet these standards, they don't qualify to be recruited into an NCAA college program.

A new initiative at Coldspring-Oakhurst High School is designed to ensure student athletes are on the right track to meet the requirements to be eligible to become an NCAA Qualifier.

Starting this year, an athletic academic advisor will work in conjunction with the high school counselor to help students align

course choices with NCAA guidelines. The adviser will also monitor GPAs and test scores.

Parents and guardians of student athletes are invited to attend an informational meeting on the new NCAA Eligibility program during the COHS Open House this Thursday, Sept. 21. The meeting will be held in room #212, beginning at 6:15 p.m. For more information, contact S.B. Pierson at 936-653-1122.
